

Bk Blauie Towards St. Helena 1879.

Thursday Sept. 11th

First part fresh trader, on Port tack, & the same throughout the day.

Lat. $8^{\circ} 21' S.$
Long. $1^{\circ} 25' East$

Friday Sept. 12th

First part strong trader, on Port tack, cloudy. Middle & latter part the same.

Lat. $9^{\circ} 24' S.$
Long. $30 miles East.$

Saturday Sept. 13th

First part fresh trader, on Port tack. Middle & latter part more moderate and cloudy, no observation.

Sunday Sept. 14th

First part moderate breeze on Port tack. Middle & latter part on S. tack.

Lat. $10^{\circ} 30' S.$
Long. $30 miles East.$

Monday Sept. 15th

First part light trader, on Starboard tack. Middle & latter part on Port tack. Raised a sail of Sperm Whales at 10 o'clock P.M. and lowered. Starboard boat struck first, then waist, then Starboard.

Lat. $11^{\circ} 08' S.$
Long. $5 miles East.$



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Tuesday Sept. 16th

First part fresh trader. Got the whales along side, and cut one in middle part one of the fluke chains parted, just before daylight and lowered the whale for the whale. Got him alongside and cut in at 11.

Lat. $10^{\circ} 52' S.$
Long. $8 miles West.$

Wednesday Sept. 17th

First part fresh trader. Cut in the other whale and got ready for fishing. Middle part fishing. Latter part the same.

Thursday Sept. 18th

First part fresh trader, fishing. Middle & latter part the same.

Lat. $10^{\circ} 47'$
Long. $15 miles West.$

Friday Sept. 19th

First part strong trader fishing. Middle part finished fishing. Latter part clearing up.

Lat. $11^{\circ} 07' S.$
Long. $17 miles East.$

Saturday Sept. 20th

First part strong trader, employed in cleaning out the air getting ready to stop down. Middle part strong breeze. Latter part strong down.

Lat. $11^{\circ} 39' S.$
