

Barck Clarke Off The Coast Of Africa 1879.

Wednesday Dec 31st

First part light trades, on Starboard tack.
Middle part the same. Latter part fresh breeze.
Long. $7^{\circ} 18' E$. Lat. $16^{\circ} 25' S$.

Thursday Jan 1st 1880

First part light trades on Starboard tack.
Middle & Latter part the same.
Lat. $15^{\circ} 34' S$. Long. $8^{\circ} 46' E$.

Friday Jan 2nd

First part light trades on Starboard tack. Middle
part the same. Latter part wind light.
Lat. $15^{\circ} 36' S$. Long. $10^{\circ} 17' E$.

Saturday Jan 3rd

First part wind light by the wind on Starboard
tack. In a sail. At windward just after
dark. Middle & Latter part light breeze and
calms.
Lat. $15^{\circ} 29' S$. Long. $11^{\circ} 29' E$.

Sunday Jan 4th

First part light breeze from the S.W.
steering E.S.E. Middle part calms. Latter
part light N.E. & S.E. sighted the W. Coast
of Africa at 10^h 10^m P.M.
Lat. $15^{\circ} 24' S$.

Monday Jan 5th

First part fine breeze from the S. steering
E. by N. Came to land anchor in Little
Fish Bay at 10^h 10^m A.M. and stood
anchor watch for the night. Latter part
employed in cleaning and painting
ship.

Tuesday Jan 6th

Fine weather all day, employed in painting
ship.

Wednesday Jan 7th

Fine light breeze. Employed in getting off rigging
and general work about the ship.

Thursday Jan 8th

Fine light trades. Latter part got underway at
daylight, and stood off shore.

Friday Jan 9th

First part fine breeze by the wind on Port tack.
Middle & Latter part the same.
Lat. $15^{\circ} 24' S$. Long. $10^{\circ} 17' E$.

Saturday Jan 10th

First part light trades. After dark. The ship
clearance 16 hrs out. Middle part on
starboard tack. Latter part on Port tack. fresh
trades.

Lat. $15^{\circ} 29' S$. Long. $10^{\circ} 05' E$.

Sunday Jan 11th

First part fresh trades on Port tack by
the wind. Middle part the same. Latter part
on Starboard tack.

Lat. $15^{\circ} 31' S$. Long. $9^{\circ} 34' E$.

Monday Jan 12th

First part fresh trades. Middle & Latter part the
same. Looking to windward. The Fish Bay
in sight.

Lat. $15^{\circ} 32' S$.
Long. $9^{\circ} 08' E$.
