

Book Daniel Off St Helena 1881

Sunday March 6th

First part fresh trades in Starboard tack, spoke the C. W. Morgan. Saw four other vessels to Edward Middle part in Port tack, latter part on Starboard tack.

Sunday March 7th

First part fresh trades in Starboard tack, Middle part on Port tack, latter part spoke the C. W. Morgan, and kept off for the Island of St Helena, Employed in fishing beach fish.

Tuesday March 8th

First part fresh trades, got off the Harbor at 3 o'clock and the Capt. went on shore and sent off the letters, then stood off on the Eastern tack, latter part spoke in off the Harbor & the Capt. came on board again.

Wednesday March 9th

First part moderate trades, stood into the Harbor and came to an anchor, at 3 o'clock, latter part employed in cleaning ship.

Thursday March 10th

Fresh trades, employed in painting ship the C. W. Morgan came in to an anchor to day.

Friday March 11th

First part squalls of rain, employed in painting ship.

Saturday March 12th

First part rainy.

Painting aloft.

Sunday March 13th

Fine weather all day, low water on shore for a mile.

Monday March 14th

Finished painting spars.

Tuesday March 15th

Employed in pumping out salt water and getting ready for fresh water.

Wednesday March 16th

Employed in filling water, and sucking out oil to ship by the C. W. Morgan.

Thursday March 17th

Employed in shipping oil on board the C. W. Morgan.
