

Bark Clarice At St Helena

Friday March 18th

Shipped the remainder of the oil on board the
Morgan, in all 194 bbls & 15 galls. Took 869 Galls of coals
from her. The Little Beard arrived at noon.

Saturday March 19th

Employed in getting ready to return off the ship, cleaning
in to 20 fath.

Sunday March 20th

Fine weather, one watch out shore for a mile.

Monday March 21st

Tuesday March 22nd

This day Capt Smith turned the ship over to Capt P. Finson who discharged
the first officer Det Anthony and shipped myself B. D. Cleveland in his place
as chief mate of the ship also discharged the 2nd officer J. B. Smith and
shipped Charles Connolly as third mate also shipped one stowaway that we
got in Healehuda latter part busy stowing the goods in the lower hold.

Wednesday March 23rd

engaged receiving provisions from the Sch. Little Beard and stowing at a quay
have employed a cooper to do what cooping that is needed to be done on board a few days.

Thursday March 24th

This day we are still receiving provisions also are taking water and
storing the ship off still employing a cooper from on shore.

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Friday March 24th 1851

This day employed stowing the ship for sea also Bought and received 240 ft of
Bark board from Bark W. Morgan also one brass long gun also Twin Shot poles got
through with the cooper and sent him on shore at 12 twelve o'clock shipped stevedores and
day they came on board and began duty. Cooks name William Wilson

Saturday March 25th 1851

To day employed getting & wood from the old Grace also set down
the fort of gallant yard to get a new band put on discharged one man
as his time had expired.

Sunday March 26th 1851

This day we are still employed getting wood and stowing it below
every thing seems to be going on nicely on board ship.

Monday March 27th 1851 all men on board

To day have been engaged getting wood also carried some iron work on shore
to have repaired that C. W. Morgan sailed to day for home carrying Capt Smith & his family
as passengers.

Tuesday March 28th

This day begins with fine weather engaged clearing up the decks also got on
Rack of B. Pick from the Bark W. Morgan gave of cash 148. no bbls 4218 latter
part work and got a set of davis also began to put them up.

Wednesday March 29th

This day ship still at anchor busy getting wood also putting up davis & bars for
another boat latter part sent some iron work on shore to have fixed for the davis

Thursday March 30th

This day engaged at various kinds of work also got one load of
wood from the Sch. Little Beard also sold to the Catholican Capt. St.
one firkin of Butter
