Saturday March 8 Sail from Dominica to
St. Eustatius, haul under all sail
set on Starboard tack Steer NW
Crew employed on work to vessel in
side

Sunday March 9 this day fresh wind from
the trade and squally at 2 P.M.
we gave "Margarette" 1000 lbs of
Capt come on board and went with
us to Anorage, at 4 P.M. we anchor
at St. Eustatius, on 6 Johnson water
found Sch "Cameo" just from
St. Eustatius, one man off duty sick

Monday March 10 at St. Eustatius with
fine weather and clear we start
painting vessel in side

Tuesday March 11 at St. Eustatius with rain
and fresh breezes from the trade
we stop painting the vessel
one of the crew and shore for treatment. With four
Wednesday March 12 at St. Eustatius with strong
wind from the trade with rain
and cloudy atmosphere

Thursday March 13 at St. Eustatius with fine
weather, we painting the boats

Friday March 14 at St. Eustatius with fresh
breezes from the trade and rain

Saturday March 15 at St. Eustatius with
clear weather and smooth sea
we take on board 30 barrels of corn and
10 barrels of sweet potatoes and one pig and others
small stuff

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Sunday March 16 at St. Eustatius with fine
weather latter part heavy rain
and cloudy atmosphere

Monday March 17 at St. Eustatius with strong
trade and rough sea on rain in
afternoon

Tuesday March 18 at St. Eustatius with moderate
trade and rain

Wednesday March 19 at St. Eustatius with light wind
from the trade at 10 AM we sail for cruise
we leave one man shore sick with fever
at 6 P.M. we shorting sail lay around the
Islands - "Cameo" also sail

Thursday March 20 this day light wind from
the trade and clear atmosphere vessel
under shorting sail cruising St. Eustatius
and St. Kitts in sight about 10 miles
Cameo in sight

Friday March 21 this day very light wind from the
trade and clear atmosphere vessel under
full sail main trysail and head sail
cruising "Cameo" in our company

Saturday March 22 this day very light wind from
the South and clear atmosphere vessel
under full sail cruising in company
with "Cameo" at sun set we shorting
sail pump attended to

Sunday March 23 this day dead calm all day
vessel under two trysails laying
abround at 10 AM we gave "Cameo"
at 5:30 P.M. we raised a school of bulls
whale we saw two boats "Cameo" also saw two boats
