Friday April 18 this day began with strong breeze from East and rough sea on vessel under two topsails and fore stay sails on starboard tack pump attended to

Saturday April 19 this day began with strong breeze from SE and cloudy atmosphere vessel under two topsails and fore on starboard tack running off shore NE at 3 P.M. we raised school of small whales going quick to windward we lower three boats but can not head them off the boats returned on board and we hoist them up lay on starboard tack pump attended to

Sunday April 20 this day began with fresh breeze from South and clear weather vessel under two topsails and fore staysail on port tack head SE at 4 P.M. blow gale with rough sea on pump attended to

Monday April 21 this day began with ~~with~~ gale from NW and clear weather very rough sea on vessel under reef fore staysail and topsails on starboard tack at 4 P.M. we were around on port tack pump attended to

Tuesday April 22 this day fresh breeze from NW with heavy swell vessel under shorting sails on port tack head NE at 5 P.M. we raised a very large whale going NE we lower three boats did not get any only one raising at dark the boat returned on board we hoist up and shorting sails pump attended to

Wednesday April 23 this day strong NW wind and squall with rain, rough sea on vessel under two topsails on starboard tack at 2 P.M. we sighted the bark "Wanderer" to the West of us at sun set we were ship to northward pump attended to

Thursday April 24 this day strong NW wind and clear atmosphere vessel under shorting sail on starboard tack at 4 P.M. we were ship on port tack "Wanderer" in sight to leeward pump attended to

Friday April 25 this day very light wind from NW and clear weather vessel under all sail set cruising "Wanderer" in sight to the leeward at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to
