The Whales went out of sight, the boats returned on board we went up and shorting sails pump attended to

Saw a Humpback and Black fish at 5 P.M. we raised a School of Small Whales we lower, three boats L.B. got a small whale, taking along at 5.30 P.M. and shorting sails and have supper pump attended to
