Wednesday May 21 this day began with moderate wind from NE and squalls with rain. Duesel under two topsails and jib on Starboard tack pump attended to

Thursday May 22 this day began with light NW wind and clear atmosphere. Duesel under all sails at cruising, at 8 PM set the shorting sails pump attended to

Friday May 23 this day strong breeze from NW and clear weather. Duesel under shorting sails on port tack, cruising at 10 A.M. we sighted a school of small whales. We lowered three boats, the boats run over the whales and the whales got white and started to windward, and went out of sight. The boats returned on board pump attended to

Saturday May 24 this day began with very light wind from SW and clear. Duesel under all sails set on port tack heading NW at 5 A.M. we sighted a school of 2 bulls. We lowered three boats. W Boat struck a 50 barrel bull the whale came hard to the harpoon breakers and losses the whale and L Boat struck a young bull. Take along side at 2.30 P.M. and hoist up the boats, and we put gear up at 3.30 P.M. produced any other school join NW. We lowered two boats. L Boat struck one of them take along side at 7.30 P.M. shorting sails pump attended to

Wednesday May 28 this day very strong wind from SE with squall and rain. Duesel under two topsails and jib on Starboard tack. Capt Sinna sick - pump attended to

Thursday May 29 this day a SE gale with rough sea on Duesel under reef fore stay sails and top sails on Starboard tack laying to. Duesel shipped much water on deck pump attended to. Capt Sinna sick

Friday May 30 this day began with very strong SW and squally all day rough sea. also Duesel under shorting sails lay to pump attended to
