Sunday June 1, This day begun with moderate wind from the NW and clear weather. Vessel under all sails set, cruising at Sun set we shorting sails pump attended to.

Monday June 2 This day begun with light wind from SE and squally weather. Vessel under shorting sails on port tack standing on windward pump attended to.

Tuesday June 3 this day begun with light wind from NE and clear weather. Vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack at 10 A.M. we raised a school of Bull Whales. We lower three boats. W.B. struck a young bull, and the whale sound had blimp from bow of J. The boats returned on board later and at 3 P.M. we raised another school of Small Whales. We lower three boats caught 5 of them. SB-2-SB-4-WB-11. Take along side and put gear up ready for cutting the next morning - we shorting sails pump attended to.

Wednesday June 4 this day light NE wind and clear atmosphere. Vessel under shorting sails on Starboard tack boiling at noon. We raised a school of Small Whales to the windward. We did not lower the boats to far to windward, at 6 P.M. we wore ship to Northward pump attended to. Capt. Senma Sick.

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Thursday June 5, this day fresh Easterly wind with squall and rain in morning. Vessel under main topsails and head sails on port tack, at 7 A.M. we raised a school of Small Whales. We lower two boats. S-Boat got stove by whale and mate took up the whale. We lower W.B. to attend the stove boat and bring along side. We caught 2 Small Whales. SB-1-SB-1- take along side at noon and we put gear up for dinner and start cutting - at 5 P.M. we finished cutting and put gear down pump attended to.

Friday June 6, this day very light wind from E and clear atmosphere. Vessel under topsail boiling down white water log was off at 6 P.M. we wore ship to North pump attended to.

Saturday this day light breeze from SE and clear weather in morning we made all sails on Starboard tack. Head off S at 3.30 P.M. we finished boiling at 4 P.M. we raised a large whale going SW-quick, we lower two boats. We did not get near at dark the boats returned on board hoist up and shorting sails, pump attended to.

Sunday June 8, This day begun with light NE wind and clear weather. Vessel under all sails set on port tack cruising at 2 P.M. we raised a large whale going SW-quick. We lower two boats. Can't head them off boat returned on board. Shorting sails pump attended to.
