Monday June 9 this day began with light SE wind and clear weather vessel under all sails set, on Starboard tack, cruising at 10 AM we raised a large blue whale going NE, we took three boats, can't head them off, boats returned on board, shorting sails pump attended to

Tuesday June 10 this day began with very light wind and calm all day vessel under no sails, set some a American Transport going West - pump attended to

Wednesday June 11 this day began with very light NE wind and clear vessel under all sails set cruising at noon we raised a school of small whale we lower three boats caught 5 of them LB=2=SB=1=W=1= take along side at 4 PM and we put gear up ready to catch, under morning pump attended to

Thursday June 12 this day fine breeze from South and clear vessel under topsails, boiling at 9 a.m. we raised a school of small whale going quick to windward, can't head them off, pump attended to

Friday June 13 this day light So. wind and clear weather vessel under all sails set cruising at Sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Saturday June 14 this day began with very light wind from the South and clear vessel under all sails set, on Starboard tack, pump attended to

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Sunday June 15 this day began with light SW wind and clear atmosphere vessel under all sails set on port tack - cruising at Sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Monday June 16 this day began with fine breeze from SE and clear atmosphere vessel under all sails set cruising at 10:30 AM we raised a school of small whales, we lower three boats, caught four LB=3=SB=1=W=1= W. Boat struck 50 barrels full and, loosing after been fast 5 hours lines burst, and SB got fast to harpoon broke off - whale went out of sight we take the other four along side, and put gear up ready to start cut the next morning, shorting sails pump attended to

Tuesday June 17 this day light Easterly wind and clear, vessel under topsails - boiling saw a Grampus pump attended to

Wednesday June 18 this day began with moderate wind from SE and clear vessel under topsails, boiling on Starboard tack - pump attended to

Thursday June 19 this day moderate wind from SW and cloudy atmosphere vessel under shorting sails set 9:30 AM we fished, boiling and set foresails and main sail on Starboard tack, at Sun set we shorting sails pump attended to
