Friday June 20 this day began with fresh breezes from the SW and squally weather under shorting sails cruising. We made general brockout and flag some casks, stow them for Joseph Water and we pump out oil from tanks at Sun set took in fore sails set fore try sails pump attended to.

Saturday June 21 this day gentle breezes from SW and squally weather under try sails fore sails and head sails cruising at 1.30 P.M. We raised a two young bulls whale going East we lower three boats L Boat - struck a young bull and the boat got stove, the S.B. took the whale and W.B. also got fast and then kill the whale we take along side 4 P.M. and start to rain heavy we taking foresails pump attended to.

Sunday June 22 this day began with squally weather and strong breezes at day light we put gear up and start cutting in at 10 A.M. finished cutting in and put gear down and start fire taken main sails set main try sails pump attended to.

Monday June 23 this day began with strong breezes from SW and squally weather under try sails and fire at 8.30 A.M. We finished boiling and set foresail on port tack, we repairing the L Boat at Sun set we shorting sails pump attended to.

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Tuesday June 24 this day began with light SW Wind and clear weather in morning. We made sails on port tack head W.B. at 10 A.M. we down "Comes" with 25 hands oil kept west board and returned at 6 P.M. we shorting sails pump attended to.

Wednesday June 25 this day began with very light SW Wind and calm. Under all sails at evening at 3.50 P.M. we lower down for Black Jack and got one S.B. at Sun set shorting sails pump attended to "Comes" in sight to the leeward.

Thursday June 26 this day began with light SW Wind and clear atmosphere in morning. We made all sails on Starboard tack cruising "Comes" in sight to leeward at Sun set we shorting sails pump attended to.

Friday June 27 this day light wind from West and clear atmosphere at daylight. We made all sails on Starboard tack head South "Comes" in sight to leeward at 1.30 P.M. we raised a School of Small whale, we lower three boats "Comes" also lower three boats, we struck three Small whale. Boat got stove, fore sail, the whale, and W.B. & L.B. & H. take this whale along side at 5 P.M. and we shorting sails, pump attended to.

Saturday 28 this day began with squally and rain in morning we start to cutting whale at 10 A.M. we finished cutting and put gear down and start fire at 5 P.M. we raised a School of Small Whale. We lower two boats, got fast and W.B. got fast and both lower whale and boat returned on board.
