

Sunday June 29 this day very light wind from East and clear atmosphere vessel under topsails and had sails boiling at day light we sight a dead whale, lost from mate the day before we lower the boat and pick up and take along side at 6.30 P.M. and put gear up and start cutting at 9 A.M. we finished cutting at 4 P.M. we finished boiling pumps attended to

Monday June 30 this day began with very light wind from West and clear at day light we made all sails on Starboard tack cruising - at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Tuesday July 1 this day began with light wind from NW and atmosphere here crew employed on repair the fore staysail at 2.30 P.M. we sight the "Cameo" to windward of us at sun set took in fore sails set fore topsails pump attended to

Wednesday July 2 this day began with very strong wind from SW and clear weather vessel under two topsails and fore staysail on Starboard tack at 10.30 A.M. we sight "Cameo" with 300 barrels at 6 P.M. we wore ship on port tack pump attended to

Thursday July 3 this day began with gale wind from SW and rough sea on vessel under two topsails on port tack head W by N - "Cameo" went out of sight pump attended to

Friday July 4 this day began with SW gale and squally and rough sea on vessel under two topsails on port tack head W - vessel shipped much water on deck pump attended to

Saturday July 5 this day began with very strong wind from SW and heavy rain and rough sea on ship under two topsails on port tack head W by N - pump attended to

Sunday July 6 this day began with moderate wind from SW and clear atmosphere at noon we set fore sails and head sails on Starboard tack head South saw lots porpoises - at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Monday July 7 this day began with very light wind from SW and foggy weather, vessel under shorting sails at 6.30 A.M. we raised a school of small whales, we lower three boats caught a small whale - W. Boat - the rest of whale went to E. Boat no chance for other boats take the whale along side at noon and we put gear up and start cutting at 4 P.M. we finished cutting and took gear down pump attended to

Tuesday July 8 this day began with fine breeze from SW and clear weather vessel under topsails on port tack at 4 P.M. we start fire pump attended to

Wednesday July 9 this day light SW wind and clear vessel under all sails set cruising at 4 P.M. we finished boiling at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Thursday July 10 this day fresh breeze from SW and squally vessel under two topsails and fore staysail on Starboard tack in morning we raised school of small whale going to windward can't find them at 8 but returned on board
