Sunday July 13 this day began with light wind from SW and clear weather at daylight we made all sails port tack head So. at 10 A.M. we gave "Margarette" & "Comes" at Sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Monday July 14 this day began with fresh Easterly wind and clear atmosphere vessel under all sails set, cruising in company with "Margarette" & "Comes" went out of sight at Sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Tuesday July 15 this day began with moderate breeze from East and clear weather Schooner under all sails set on port tack cruising in company with "Margarette" at Sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Wednesday July 16 this day began with gentle breeze from East and cloudy vessel under foreails main trysail and head sails cruising in company of "Margarette" at Sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Thursday July 17 this day began with moderate wind from East and clear atmosphere vessel under all sails set on port tack head South at 4 P.M. we gave Schrs "Woodrough" with 300 barrels oil "Margarette" in sight to the leeward at Sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Friday July 18 this day began with fresh breeze from East and clear Schooner under foreails and head sails and trysails head S.W. - both vessels "Margarette" & "Woodrough" went out of sight pump attended to

Saturday July 19 this day began with light Easterly wind and clear weather Schrs under all sails set on port tack head So. at Sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Sunday July 20 this day began with very light wind from SE and clear atmosphere Schrs under all sails set on port tack head S.W. at 10 A.M. we spotted "Woodrough" killing a small whale at Sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Monday July 21 this day began with very light SW wind and clear Schrs "Woodrough" with boats down to the windward of us chasing whale and she caught some at Sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Tuesday July 22 this day began with light wind from SW and clear atmosphere at daylight we made all sails on Starboard tack at 9 A.M. we were Sup on port tack and at 10:30 A.M. we raised a school of small whale we have three boats caught 5 small whales SB-2-WB-3-LB got star head by whale, and did not get any
