Wednesday July 23 this day very light wind from West and clear atmosphere vessel under Main trysail and head sails on Starboard tack head S.W. by W at daylight we start cutting whale at 9 A.M. we finished cutting and start fire "Woodruff" in sight boiling Capt. repaired the L. Boat - pump attended to

Thursday July 24 this day calm and light air vessel under trysail at 4 P.M. we finished boiling "Woodruff" in sight pump attended to

Friday July 25 this day light wind from S.E. and clear atmosphere vessel under all sails set for Starboard tack cruising at S.W. by W set the Shorting sail pump attended to, "Woodruff" in sight

Saturday July 26 this day light breeze from East and clear atmosphere at daylight we made all sails on port tack at 9 A.M. "Woodruff" packed two bull whales the lower two boats and we lower three, "Woodruff" caught one in dim' got away the boat returned on board we Shorting sails pump attended to

Sunday July 27 this day light S.E. wind and clear atmosphere at daylight we made all sails on port tack, cruising at S.W. by W set the Shorting sail pump attended to "Woodruff" in sight boiling

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Monday July 28 this day very light wind from East and equally weather vessel under two trysails, on port tack, "Woodruff" in sight

Tuesday July 29 this day fresh Easterly wind and clear weather, under Shorting sails cruising "Woodruff" in sight pump attended to

Wednesday July 30 this day light wind from S.E. and squally in morning the "Woodruff" raised a school of bull whales. She lower two boats and we lower three boats mated with us we caught young bulls "Woodruff" took whale along side we went over help cutting at 4:30 P.M. we finished cutting and raised any other school of bulls. Lower boats again and one of "Woodruff" boats struck young bull take all the lines the boat returned on board pump attended to

Thursday July 31 this day light Easterly wind and clear weather at daylight we made all sails on Starboard tack cruising some lots of porpoises, "Woodruff" in sight boiling at sun set we Shorting sails pump attended to

Friday August 1 this day fresh Southerly wind and clear vessel under Shorting sails cruising, we kill pig in morning and we send one gutted board "Woodruff" pump attended to
