Monday August 4 this day light wind from South cloudy weather at day light we made all sails on port tack standing to Westward Crewe making senets pump attended to

Tuesday August 5 this day light S.W. wind and clear atmosphere in morning we made all sails on port tack cruising Crewe making senets at Sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Wednesday August 6 this day began with fine breeze from S.W. and clear atmosphere. Under all sails cruising at Sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Thursday August 7 this day began with light S.W. wind, clear atmosphere. Under all sails set, cruising at Sun set shorting sails pump attended to

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Friday August 8 this day fresh breeze from West and clear atmosphere at day light we made all sails on port tack cruising at Sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Saturday August 9 this day began with fresh North Wind and cloudy weather. Under all sails set on port tack, at 1.30 P.M. we raised a school of bull whales, we lower three boats, the whales got the boat, start to Windward back returned on board at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Sunday August 10 this day began with light S.W. wind and clear atmosphere. Under all sails set, cruising at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Monday August 11 this day began with very light wind from S.W. and clear atmosphere. Under all sails set, cruising. Saw lots of porpoises, and Grampas, Gravis in sight at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Tuesday August 12 this day began with light S.W. wind and squally weather. Under all sails set, cruising at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Wednesday August 13 this day began with light S.W. wind and clear weather at day light we made all sails on port tack head S.W. at 2.30 P.M. we raised a school of small whale we lower three boats S Boat Catch - a small whale, we take along side at 4.30 P.M. we put gear up and cutting in at 8 P.M. we fowled and shorting sails pump attended to
