

The Ship Clementia from New London May
Wednesday At 9 AM got under way and stood three
June 1st the sea down towards Montauk & on
thick fog and rain

Thursday Begins this day with thick fog and rain
June 1st at two the pilot left and we proceeded
to sea at 3 PM Montauk Point & Dore
West from which I take my departure
some sail in light breeze but calm
Tatter for the same Sea No Ob

Friday Begins this day with light winds and
June 1st ends with light winds and clear sea ships
in sight

Saturday June begins this day with thick fog
and rain at two the pilot
left and we proceeded
to sea at 3 PM Montauk Point & Dore
West from which I take my departure
some sail in light breeze but calm
Tatter for the same Sea No Ob
