

**Monday** July 17<sup>th</sup> The Ship *Colomatic* of New London 1837  
 Commences this day with pleasant breeze from the East and pleasant sun a very School of Blackfish the Middle clearing the Latter part clear so ends

**Tuesday** July 18<sup>th</sup> All these twenty four hours light breezes from the East and clear saw a Ship steering S West so ends Lat 18.07 Lon by Chron 23.24

**Wednesday** July 19<sup>th</sup> Commences this day with light winds from the S West and heavy the Middle part clear at 5 o'clock made St Antunes bearing S by East 20 miles the Latter part fine breeze and clear so ends 17.00

**Thursday** July 20<sup>th</sup> Begins the day with fine breeze from the S East and pleasant sun some Blackfish leard and struck one took him a long side his jaws broke and lost him so ends Lat Lon

**Friday** July 21<sup>st</sup> Commences this day with light winds from the S East and pleasant sun a Ship steering to the southward made the Isl of Brazil bearing S by West dist 20 miles

**Saturday** July 22<sup>nd</sup> Begins this day with light winds from the S East and clear the Middle part fresh breezes and clear four sails in sight the Latter light winds and cloudy so ends Lat by Chron 12.29

**Sunday** July 23<sup>rd</sup> The first part of these twenty four hours light winds from the Eastward and cloudy two Ships steering to the Southward the Middle the same saw a School of Blackfish leard and struck one both jaws broke seven sails in sight Ends Lat

**Monday** July 24<sup>th</sup> Towards the Coast of Chile 1837  
 Begins this day with fresh breezes from the Eastward and squally at one Wick in the Top gallant sails and Heft the Fore and Mizzen Toppails the Middle part pleasant the Latter part the same spoke a French Ship bound to the Coast of Chile 6 sails in sight so ends Lat by Chron 11.12

**Tuesday** July 25<sup>th</sup> Commences this day with light breezes and pleasant the Middle and Latter part calm saw Blackfish leard and struck one and cleared so ends Lat 11.2

**Wednesday** July 26<sup>th</sup> These twenty four hours begins with fine breeze from the S East and east the Middle and Latter part the fine Sails in sight so ends Lat 9.59 Lon by Chron 20.1

**Thursday** July 27<sup>th</sup> Commences this day with fine breeze from the S East and clear the Middle part the same the Latter part light winds from the S East and squally 6 sails in sight so ends Lat 9.11 Lon

**Friday** July 28<sup>th</sup> Commences this day with fresh breezes from the S West and squally the Middle and Latter part the same 2 sails in sight so ends Lat 10.50

**Saturday** July 29<sup>th</sup> Begins this day with light breeze and cloudy the wind S West the Middle clear Latter part squally and plenty of rain the wind from the West and three sails in sight ends No Obs Lat by Chron 11.20

**Sunday** July 30<sup>th</sup> Commences this day with fine breeze from the S East and rainy the Middle and Latter part clear 3 sails in sight so ends Lat 6.42 Lon 21.27

**Monday** July 31<sup>st</sup> This day begins with light breeze from the S West and clear 2 sails in sight Middle pleasant Latter part
