

Ship, Clements Crusing for Whales 1838

Saturday Jan 27th 1838
Began this day with hard gales from the West and S.W. Equally Middle and Latter part more moderate cut in the whale board for two other whales but did not get fast. So Ends Lat 43.4

Sunday Jan 28
Commenced this day with strong breeze from the W and pleasant Middle part Equally the Latter part hard gales abated with rain. So Ends Lat 43.20 Long 17.20

Monday Jan 29
Began this day with hard gales Middle part the same Latter part spoke the black stone two whales in the water saw several whales board once did not get fast. So Ends Lat 43.12 Long 17.15

Tuesday Jan 30
Began this with hard gales finished blowing down the oil till the foreteller on board and then another Middle and Latter part the same as the former. So Ends Lat 42.48 Long 16.57

Wednesday Jan 31
Commenced this day with strong breeze from the W and at usual split the skin of the sails and went another Middle and Latter part the same as the former. So Ends the day Lat 42.43 Long by Chron 14.19 Lines 14.00

Thursday February 1st 1838
Began this day with strong breeze from the W and Equally run to the Eastward Middle part took in sail Latter part kept her off to the East at 11 sail one whale did not hear it being a heavy squall. So Ends

Friday Feb 2nd
Commenced this day with a light breeze and a heavy swell on sea whale heard thick two took on along, saw and cut his body in it being so mugged the we could not get his hula there much but the other whale so Middle and Latter part hard gales. So Ends the day no obs

Saturday Feb 3rd
Began this day with hard gales carried a double reef top sails. We tried to find the other whale Middle part the same Latter part obliged to take in the foreteller. So Ends plenty of hail Lat 42.26 Long 12.55

Sunday Feb 4th
Began this day with hard gales from the W and Equally employed in boiling muddles the same Latter part more moderate and of rain. So Ends Lat 42.55

Monday Feb 5th
Commenced this day with hard gales took in the top sails Middle and Latter part the same as the former

Tuesday Feb 6th
First part of these twenty four hours began with gales finished blowing down the oil Middle more Latter part the same steering to the Eastward

Wednesday Feb 7th
Began this day with thick foggy weather Middle part pleasant Latter part the same. So Ends Lat Long

Thursday Feb 8th
Commenced this day with strong breeze from the W and lowing Middle and Latter part the same at 11 sail one whale got on from out of the fog. So Ends the day

Friday Feb 9th
Began this day with foggy weather Middle part the same Latter part saw a dead whale took him along side and got one from out of him and set him go. So Ends mugged

Saturday Feb 10th
The first part of these twenty four hours began with strong breeze saw one right whale board but did not get fast Middle and Latter part strong breeze. Lat 42.03 Long 6.41

Sunday Feb 11th
Began this day with strong breeze W and part of the Middle part hard gales Latter part saw one right whale board did not get fast. So Ends Lat 42.16 Long 12.50

Monday Feb 12th
Commenced with thick hazy weather saw one whale board found him going to the Westward quick Middle and Latter part pleasant. So Ends Lat 42.11 Long 12.10

Tuesday Feb 13th
Began this day with fine weather Middle part thick foggy weather Latter part the same. So Ends the day Lat 42.12
