 Sunday May 16th Began this day with strong breeze and squally the Middle and Latter part the same the wind I had saw some kites the Stoungton in company so ends Lat 25.58
 Monday May 17th Commenced this day with strong breeze from the S.W. attended with light squalls of rain till the forenoon 18 by 20 Middle and Latter part the same so ends Lat 25.58
 Tuesday May 18th The first part of these twenty four hours began with hard squalls from the South East and attended with rain till the forenoon 18 by 20 Middle and Latter part pleasant so ends Lat 25.58
 Wednesday May 19th Commenced this day with fine breeze and clear sky till the Middle strong breeze the Latter part strong breeze and squally the wind in the North West so ends Lat 25.58
 Thursday May 20th Began this day with fine breeze from the S.W. and attended with the Stoungton in company Middle part pleasant the Latter part the same so ends Lat 25.58
 Friday May 21st Commenced this day with light breeze from the S.W. with a heavy sailing swell on the forenoon in full of the forenoon strong the Middle part breeze squalls attended with rain till the forenoon 18 by 20 Middle and Latter part the same so ends the day Lat 25.58
