Monday June 11

Commenced this day with hard gales from the West attended with heavy squalls of rain the middle part more moderate the latter part pleasant stood up for the land hoard a party on shore saw a number of who struck two laid one and took her along side of the ship to end

Tuesday June 12

Smooth sea and light squalls of rain till the whole along side and commenced cutting the middle part moderate started the work the latter part hard gales employed in hauling three ships in sight so ends the day

Wednesday June 13

Commenced this day with hard gales from the West an cloudy pale the middle part the latter part finished hauling stood over to St Pauls spoke the Whales of Warrington laying another clothing a whale so ends

Thursday June 14

Begins this day with strong breeze from the West and heavy squalls of rain till the middle part thick rainy weather the latter part heavy gales one ship in sight so ends the day

Friday June 15

Commenced this day with hard gales from the West thick rainy weather the middle part the same the latter part thick rainy weather so ends

Saturday June 16

Begins this day with fresh breeze from the East and heavy the middle part hawking winds attended with squalls of rain the latter part fresh gales St Pauls in sight split the middle part so ends the day

Sunday June 17

Commenced this day with fresh gales from the West attended with heavy squalls of hail and rain the middle part the same the latter part fresh breeze and squally so ends the ships in sight

Monday June 18

Begins this day with fine weather Warrington's whale and cut the middle and latter part the same so ends

Tuesday June 19

Commenced this day with light breeze and pleasant weather struck the whale the crew saved from one of the boats cut the line off with the spoke from the other four ships in sight the Warrington got a whale so ends the day

Wednesday June 20

Commenced this day with fine weather pulchre wind struck three whales on shore boat the other cut a line and left one so ends the day got very late but very bad and so

Thursday June 21

Begins this day with fine weather pulled in a line struck a whale held her and took him along side at 2 PM commenced cutting the middle and latter part three and

Friday June 22

Commenced this day with hard gales from the West pulchre under the middle and latter part the same so ends

Saturday June 23

Begins this day with strong gales from the West spoke the latter part the same employed in hauling the middle and latter part the same so ends

Sunday June 24

Commenced this day with strong breeze from the West and squally the ships in sight the middle and latter part more moderate so ends

Monday June 25

Begins this day with fine breeze and pleasant weather the to the West pulled in under one spoke and the son draws middle and latter part the same three ships in sight two a cutting

Tuesday June 26

Commenced this day with strong breeze under cover struck a whale told her along side and cut her got the fore Whales clatt swift and headed to the West at one o'clock shifted a sea and took the boat and carried away the latter part the middle part in sight it being very late but very bad and so ends the day
