

*Ship Clement of St. Louis 1838*

*Tuesday June 27* Commenced this day with hard squalls of wind and rain Middle part the same latter part more moderate wind steady being handy but did not go in shore having but on boat to leave boards

*Wednesday June 28* Began this day with strong breeze from the N.W. fell in to and struck one whale killed no whale and set him in middle part the same latter part gales employed in bottling & Thaps in light

*Thursday June 29* This day began with heavy gales from the N.W. broke out the fore hold on the fore hold side and stole down to the N.W. of Middle and latter part the same on ship in light employed in bottling

*Friday June 30* Began this day with hard gales from the N.W. and squally employed in bottling and steering down Middle and latter hard gales boards

*Saturday July 1* Commenced this day with hard gales from the N.W. and squally Middle and latter part the same employed in bottling so ends the day

*Sunday July 2* Began this day with strong breeze at 9 P.M. blew a hurricane finished bottling and took in the main & fore sails at 2 P.M. on carriage away the latter quarter boat Middle part squally rain and hail and snow and the wind without any double lashed the sail took on deck the latter part the same as the former so ends

*Monday July 3* Commenced this day with a little relaxation to the wind got the water to rise on the spinnaker blew all to pieces and the fore sails on bent them to mend middle part more moderate for the fore sail latter part quite pleasant Howard down the oil the carpenter employed about the boat to have put one boat that we can leave the other being perfect wrecked state & much as the ship being so so ends the day

*Tuesday July 4* Began this day with hard gales as usual the carpenter employed in mending both the boats in repairing the Middle and latter part the same so ends

*Wednesday July 5* Began this day with hurricanes all sails in stack the storm sails Middle and latter part the same so ends the day

*Thursday July 6* Commenced this day hard gales from the N.W. Middle and latter part the same so ends

*Friday July 7* The first part of this twenty four hours began with hard gales at times with hail and rain and snow Middle and latter part the same so ends the day

*Saturday July 8* Commenced this day with strong breeze from the N.W. part out of the fore sails the wind N.W. and cold day employed in repairing the main & fore sails the fore sails in the fore hold the Middle and latter part light breeze and a shower so ends

*Sunday July 9* Began this day with a calm weather and clear employed in repairing sails and boats the Middle and latter part light breeze from the N.W. and fair weather so ends the day *Part 35-46*

*Monday July 10* Commenced this day with strong breeze from the N.W. and part out the fore sails the carpenter employed in repairing the Middle and latter part full gales took in the fore and main fore sails and fore sails the main so ends the day

*Tuesday July 11* Began this day with strong breeze from the N.W. and fair weather the Middle and latter part more moderate so ends employed in repairing both

*Wednesday July 12* This day began with hard gales from the N.W. and hail heavy to the fore and under deck so ended the day so ended the day
