 same two ships in sight. Is End this day of our Lord

Sunday July 13th - Begun this day with light breeze from the South accompanied with squalls of rain and snow. A red sun in sight at the departure of the ship sails and set main top gallant sail. Made a fair port pleasant three days in sight. Employed in that business so ended.

reel beard out of him so ends this day

July 20 boiling ebullite and latter part the same do. End
Lat 35 14

Saturday began this day with a hard gale from the N.E. and
July 21. Equally Middle and latter part the same so ends.

begin this day fresh brues and cloudy the wind
SE and the clouds and latter part light but with
a heavy riding swell on broke out the after hatch and
flowed down 75 bbls oil so ends the Day

July 24

This air begins to be lighter from SS 27 and toward
middle part the sand the latter part the same as the
former at hand. *Emphyta* in deep sandy bedded

Wednesday
July 23

Commenced this day with light winds and fair
 weather the wind East the Middle and South
 Lane Sale some five backs so ended the day
 Fall 28-38 Long by Chron 73.12

Thursday
July 28

Begins this day with light air and fair, within the
 town Port the Middle and latter the fair
 Lat 27.39 Long by Lunar 73.42 by Chron 73.00

Friday
July 27

All these twenty four hours light buds and cheer
Neither saw nor felt back to eyes the way
Left 27 25 Long by Chert 73

July 2.

Commenced this day with light breeze from the SEth
and clear weather the middle and latter part of
day. Sp. 3. 41. Pitt 27.00. Sp. 41.
