 at three the Pilot came on board of us at 6 o'clock
 to anchor out, side of the hill being in sight
 of water Coral bottom 60 fathoms of Channel further
 the sailed and the Capt went ashore to end
 the day
 Wednesday 8 This day all hands employed in repairing the
 August 8 rigging sent down the Cross Jack yard and on one
 Thursday 9 all hands employed in getting of water and
 August 9 storing it down the fore hold to end
 August 10 Began this day with light breeze and fair weather
 Saturday 11 all hands employed in watering the
 August 11 the National Frigate and three masted
 Sunday 12 some came off French and from
 August 12 the Port was visited and there was liberty
 to end the day
