Sunday
 1838 Commenced this day with light breeze and pleasant weather. Took my whale line. Struck her head and took her along side and cut her in the middle part pleasant. Started the hook the latter the same to end the day. Lat 36.54 Long 39.44

Monday
 1838 Began this day with light breeze from the East and fair weather. Employed in pulling the middle and latter part the same day. 3 Whales taken. Struck one killed and took her along side and cut her in to end the day. Lat 36.59 Long 39.55

Tuesday
 1838 Commenced this day with pleasant weather. Wind down at 10 AM down the after hatch. Middle part the same the latter part the same. 1 Whale taken. Struck her head and took her along side to end the day. Lat 37.00 Long 39.56

Wednesday
 1838 Commenced this day with fair weather. Cut the skin in employment in pulling the middle part the same the latter part the same. Employed in pulling to end. Lat 37.45 Long 39.51

Thursday
 1838 Commenced this day with fair weather. Saw a school of black porpoise and a few other small porpoise. The latter part the same. Ship to windward taking down the whale to end. Lat 37.48 Long 39.56

Friday
 1838 Began this day with pleasant weather. Finest killing. Middle and latter part rugged. End. Lat 37.42 Long 39.54

Saturday
 1838 Commenced this with fine breeze with a small on. Saw 2 bright whales and a number of fin back. Struck one killed and took her along side. Middle thick. Rainy weather. Latter part the ship and cut the whale in to the lower part to the hook to end the day. Lat 38.00 Long 39.44

Sunday
 1838 Commenced this day with thick haze. Weather dark. Fin 7. Took the middle part pleasant. The latter part from the north to end the day. Lat 38.15 Long 39.50

Monday
 1838 Began this day with strong breeze from the East. Thick fog. Weather the middle part finest. Pulling the latter part many squalls attended with rain. Thunder and lightning. Wind down to end the day. Lat 38.15 Long 39.50

Tuesday
 1838 Commenced this day with fine breeze from the East and small squalls. The middle part the same. Wind to the north the latter part the same. Lat 37.00 Long 39.55

Wednesday
 1838 Began this day with light breeze from the East and pleasant weather. The middle part the same. Middle and latter part the same. Ends during to the north. Lat 37.00 Long 39.55

Thursday
 1838 Commenced this day with light breeze from the East. Middle and latter part the same. The middle part thick foggy weather. Whale taken to end the day. Lat 37.00 Long 39.55

Friday
 1838 Commenced this day with pleasant weather. The middle part the same. The middle thick. Rainy weather. Attended with squalls and lightning. The latter part pleasant. Lat 38.00 Long 39.55

Saturday
 1838 Began this day with light breeze from the East. Middle and latter part the same. The middle part thick haze. Weather the latter part the same. To end 37.19 Long 39.01
