Sunday This day commences this day with strong
July 9 breeze from the South Middle and latter
part the same to Enay, strong Eby S
Lat 39° 40' Long 127° 11'

Wednesday Commences this day with fresh breeze from
July 10 the S.W. and Eby S. some weak
S.W. breeze did not get past Middle and
latter part the same as the former
Lat 39° 30'

Thursday Begins this day with strong breeze from
July 11 W by S and squally weather during E by S
at 4 P.M. within the Gulf of California
and double height the S.W. breeze
made a sail. Latter part the same
to Enay the day is E by S

Friday These twenty four hours begins with light
July 12 breeze pleasant weather calm Lat 39° 39' Long 127° 11'
same as the former the land is

Saturday All this day light breeze and pleasant
July 13 weather the same W by S strong E by S
Lat 39° 46' Long 127° 16'

Sunday These twenty four hours light breeze
and pleasant weather the same S.W.
July 14 Lat 39° 43' Long 126° 23'

Monday This day fine breeze and fair weather
July 15 spoke the steamer of S.W. and S.W.
1 month out 230 lbs of sperm 150 lbs of
lard and 200 lbs of oil Lat 39° 40'

weather at 3 P.M. took in the S.W. sails
at 4 P.M. took in the S.W. sails and
E by S 20 miles at 10 P.M. took in

on shore 4 ships in S.W. to Enay

July 18 west the launch came along side and took
so 100 lbs of oil a show the Middle thick fog
and rain for the S.W. of S.W. sailing
to Enay

Friday Begins this day with fresh breeze and pleasant
July 19 weather beat up between S.W. and S.W.
at 3 P.M. the launch came along side with the
scurvy at 5 the Capt. came aboard and began
up the boat made all sail and proceeded
on our passage Middle and latter part
pleasant S.W. sailing in S.W. to Enay
Lat 36° 55'
