October 3 the west and cloudy middle and latter part
the same Lat 36° 57' Long 53° 27' by R. S. S. S.

Wednesday behaved fine breeze from E. S. E. and pleasant
Oct 4 Middle part hazy latter part the same
Saw 2 white whales going quick to the N. E.
P. O. but did not get fast. P. O. S. S. S.
Lat 37° 15' Long 56° 00'

Thursday Began this day with strong breeze from
October 5 the N. E. and hazy middle and latter part
the same P. O. S. S. S. Lat 38° 19' Long 60° 51'

Friday Began with strong breeze from the N. E.
October 6 and pleasant hazy middle and latter
part the same P. O. S. S. S. Lat 38° 56'

Saturday Commenced this day with strong breeze
October 7 from the N. E. and hazy middle and latter
part the same

Sunday Began this day with strong breeze from
October 8 the N. E. and hazy middle and latter
part the same

Monday First part of these twenty four hours with
October 9 fine breeze from the N. E. and pleasant
middle and latter part the same
Saw some fine whales Lat 37° 17' Long 60° 00'

Tuesday Began this day with fine breeze from
October 10 the west and cloudy middle and
latter part the same Lat 37° 00'

Crusing for Whales 1839
October Commenced this day with light breeze and cloudy
Sunday 13 weather spoke the *Amaron* of Fair Haven
Capt Smith 11 months out 280 blb Sprm
Lat 34° 34' Long 92° 20'

October Commenced this day with strong breeze and
Monday 14 pleasant weather middle thick hazy
weather Double reef the tops Lat 34° 34'
Saw one white whale loose saw no more
of him Lat 34° 47' Long 93° 01' Saw another
white whale the next day in Lat 34° 49'
Long 97° 20'

Sunday Saw nothing more until Oct 20
October 20 fine breeze until the 20th saw 2 Sprm
whales loose struck one killed and took him
along side and cut him in P. O. S. S. S. this
day with fine pleasant weather
Lat 32° 40' Long 106°

Monday Spoke the ship *Main* of Fair Haven
October 21 1700 blb 16 months out showed down
the Sprm oil we have most of the
Monroe time fresh blb from the water
October 22 spoke the *Solo* Hunter Bell taken
85 blb Sprm one white whale full from
home

Thursday Spoke the ship *Stonington* of New
October 31 London whales 6 months out
the *Stonington* had the mate of the
and part of the ship *George* of New London Capt. S. S. S.
on the 1st of November from Long Point
