Saturday Nov 30 Begins this day with strong
breeze from the south west middle part the same
rather part more moderate storm so blows down
the fore back employees in boiling & Enas

Lat 38° 40 Long 124° 13

Saw one white whale

Sunday Begins this day with fine pleasant weather
decreasing the wind from the NW to the NE
and heading to the south saw a number of fin backs
we saw the white whales to the south of the fin back
saw a ship to be a boiling middle and rather
part calm & Enas Lat 38° 40 Long 124° 30

Monday Commenced this day with the breeze and
decreasing the weather to a number of
fin backs saw one white whale struck him
and took him along side and cut him in spoke the
America she had cut 5 white whales to be a
middle and rather part strong breeze blowing
to the south and employees in boiling and blowing
down Lat 39° 09 Long 124° 50

Tuesday Commenced this day with strong breeze from
decreasing the weather further the tops middle and
rather part thick foggy employees in boiling and
blowing down & Enas Lat 39° 21 Long 124° 55

Wednesday Begins this day with pleasant weather the wind
decreasing from the NW to the NE and heading to the
south saw a number of fin backs saw one white whale
we had to look for him Lat 39° 15 middle part to be a
middle and rather part strong breeze and thick fog squally
saw one white whale bore struck him took him along
side and cut him in 2 ships in the middle and
a 1/2 of the men saw the whale & took him off subject a long time
the other 1/2 of the men saw the whale & took him off subject a long time

Trading for Whales 1839

Thursday Commenced this day with thick foggy
decreasing the wind from the east further
cutting the whale the middle part the wind
headed to the south west rather part saw 2
white whales struck one and sank him employees
in boiling and blowing down Lat 38° 57
Long 124° 31

Friday Begins this day with more moderate weather
decreasing the wind from the NW to the NE
saw 1 white whale bore did not get fast
spoke the Black Stone of Groton 800
6 months out middle part fine weather rather
part 1/2 of the men saw the whale took him along
side the Verba saw employees in boiling
Lat 38° 30

Saturday This day fine pleasant weather further
decreasing the wind from the NW to the NE
saw 2 white whales did not get
fast the black stone in sight saw 6 fin
backs & Enas the day Lat 39° 09
Long 124° 00 East

Sunday Commenced this day with calm weather
decreasing the wind from the NW to the NE
saw 2 white whales bore struck him
and took him along side the black stone
saw 1 white whale & Enas Lat 39° 30
Long 124° 50

Monday We have fine pleasant weather cut the
white whale in rather part saw 6 fin backs
struck him and the snow drove
Lat 39° 33 Long 124° 32

Tuesday This day fine pleasant weather saw 6 fin backs
saw 1 white whale bore struck him took him along
side and cut him in 2 ships in the middle and
a 1/2 of the men saw the whale & took him off subject a long time
the other 1/2 of the men saw the whale & took him off subject a long time
