Jan 10 the P.W. steering P.E. S.W. a number of whales
scared struck and the line got cut off by
the S.W. breeze one ship in site Lat 43° 30' Long 128° 30'

Thursday Began this day with more moderate
S.W. breeze the four whales that we had
killed the day before beat up to him and took her
along side a heavy swell on let him lay all
night for him to cut let day him cut the whale
in started the work Lat 43° 30' Long 128° 30'

Friday Commenced this day with light breeze from the
Jan 12 P.W. & S.W. 3 whales going quick to the
P.E. One not yet fast Middle and Potter
strong S.W. breeze once heavy S.W. 2 whales
P. Enos

Jan 13 more white whales this day than we have
seen in one day before landed did not get fast
since latter part fine weather S.W. 2 white
whales scared struck like took him along side S.W.
whales struck the whale killed and left him
dead on the water came on the foggy last side
of the ship for some time P. Enos

Jan 14 Employed in pulling S.W. no whaling
the whales appear to be working to the eastward

Friday All this day fine pleasant weather
Jan 15 found the whale the we had killed took

Saturday Began this day with light breeze from
Jan 16 so they cut down the after back Middle
Potter part fresh breeze
Lat 43° 30' Long 128° 30'

Sunday All this day fresh S.W. breeze from the
Jan 18 Steer P.E. Emp. in pulling and storing
down S.W. a ship steering with
P. Enos Lat 44° 14'

Monday Commenced this day with fresh S.W. breeze
Jan 19 from the South & farther the fore sail
and Main Sails made and Pot is part
the S.W. breeze latter S.W. 2 white whales
going quick to the Eastward spoke the captain
for Harbour 1000 S.W. S.W. of Town
steering to the East Lat 44° 30' 128° 30'
