

1840 Ship Remates Bounce Eastward
Friday all this day fresh breeze from NW
Feb 15 and fair weather

Lat 43° 39 Longitude 156° 31
Saturday Commenced this day with fair breeze and
Feb 16 fair weather broke out the Freddion once
Commenced a shower at 10 o'clock to Enay

Latitude 46° 36 Long 158° 30
Sunday Commenced this day with strong breeze
Feb 16 from the westward steering ESE employ
in repairing the sails and setting up shooks
Middle and latter like breeze and clear weather
Lat 47° 33 Long 160° 10

Monday We have fine pleasant weather saw 2 whales
Feb 17 whale's going quick to the eastward called
them and they tore down the front part of the top
works and bits them up a fresh middle strong breeze
steering East latter the same sails 2 whales loosed from
the 2 whales and towed me out him to the seaward
to Enay Lat 48° 48 Long 162° 50

Tuesday Begins this day with strong breeze from
Feb 18 west Bounce East saw one white whale
and the fore drakes double next the 13th
to Enay this day with thick fog and rainy weather
at 10 hauld on a brace and heading west 4 W
to Enay Lat by obs 48° 46 Long by obs 164° 40

Wednesday Commenced this day with thick foggy and
Feb 19 the wind was heading SW employ
in boiling middle part the same latter fresh
obs upon the last and thick rainy weather

to Enay Lat by obs 49° 00
Long 165° 00

Ship Clements Bounce to New Zealand 1840
Thursday Commenced this day with strong breeze from
Feb 20 was W and squally middle the same hauld
to SW broken cloudy weather latter more moderate
set the 4th sails 2 white whales loosed and
did not get fast Lat 49° 36 Long 167° 49

Friday Begins this day with strong breeze and
Feb 21 fair weather middle and latter the same to En
the wind South

Lat by obs 49° 38 171° 30 Long
Saturday Begins this day with fresh breeze from
Feb 22 was W and fair weather middle foggy double
next 13th working to the west and East latter
part the same Latitude 49° 38 Long 171° 40

Sunday All this day thick foggy with the wind
Feb 23 to the eastward to Enay

Monday Whose twenty four hours thick foggy with
Feb 24 the wind was heading west by South at
mid night wore ship heading East latter strong
breeze from SW and fair weather to Enay

Latitude 49° 08 Long 172° 20 34
Tuesday We have like baffling breeze attended with
Feb 25 thick fog and rainy the wind chiefly
from the westward part the same on the
13th middle and latter part the same as the
former to Enay Lat 48° 13 Long 172° 58 30 34

Wednesday Commenced this day with thick drizzly weather
Feb 26 the wind South steering SW saw some
fine backs middle and latter thick fog and
rainy at usual to Enay Lat by obs 48° 50 34
