 Sunday two Sundays come to gether
 March's Commenced this day with strong breeze from
 ESE the ship sailing very heavy finished boating set
 next tops heading N 28° E on a lance made more
 moderate latter toward the 6th down Pale a plenty
 of black fish to E end Latitude 32° 48 Long 178° 43 West

Monday Commenced this day with lites baffling winds
 March's finished showing the 6th down once clear
 the hoare made all sail the wind N 28° E heading
 East bounder Moone off the 6th once off the main
 Latitude 32° 32 Long 178° 30 heads for home

Tuesday all this day lites from the North
 March 10 and fair weather
 Latitude 32° 48 Long 176° 47

Wednesday Commenced this day with lites breeze from
 March 11 to 12 and fair weather middle once latter
 part the same to E end
 Latitude 32° 41 Long

Thursday These twenty four hours lites breeze from the
 March 12 with some lightning double reef
 the tops latter fresh breeze let the reef out and
 set the main top Sallant sail to E
 Latitude 32° 36 Long 176° 20

Friday We have fine pleasant weather the breeze from
 March 13 N 28° E middle once latter part the same
 Latitude by 32° 27 Long 167° 34

Saturday Commenced this day with thick clouds
 March 14 weather the breeze N 28° E middle once
 latter part the same Lat 32° 26 Long 163° 45

Sunday Begins this day with fresh breeze from N
 March 15 middle thick foggy latter rainy
 Latitude 32° 20 Long 160° 05

 Monday All this day strong breeze from N 28° E
 March 16 thick cloudy rainy weather
 Latitude 32° 48 Long 176° 47

Tuesday Commenced this day with lites breeze

 March 19 strong breeze from the South latter
 with hail rain once Snow middle once
 latter part more moderate with 6, rough
 to E end Latitude 32° 49 Long 147° 49

Friday Commenced this day with more moderate
 March 20 weather middle part equally same to
 latter part fresh breeze made all sail
 to E end the wind west
 Latitude 32° 03 Longitude 147° 26

 for 20 days
 Sunday These twenty four hours begins with lites breeze
 March 21 and cloudy middle heavy squalls took in the
 sliding sails and furled the main tops Gal sail
 Double reef the tops latter part thick rainy
 weather to E end
