

Ship *Arcturion* N.E. London 1841
 Friday Commenced this day with fine breeze from the
 subject S.W. and thick hazy weather Middle part
 once raining at Day till the hauls to the
 west where blew very heavy the rain fell
 in torrents furl the fore and mizzen
 tops & crew sea on our new Tabor 2
 sea sick and some homesick and some
 scarcely saw the sun. Since we left S.E.
 Lat Account 39° 35' Long by Log 61° 38'

Saturday Commenced this day with heavy gales from the
 August 8 and thick hazy weather furl the fore and
 mizzen tops midnite moderate set the
 fore tops double reef Tatter part of once
 midnite to end Latitude 39° 38' Long 59°
 How men off Duty Sick

Sunday Commenced this day with strong breeze from S.W.
 August 9 fair weather till sail set Middle and Tatter
 brace once weather the same S.W. some 28 knots
 fish to end Latitude by obs 40° 08' Long 59°

Monday Begins this day with light breeze and squalls
 August 10 of rain attended with thunder and lightning
 midnite the same Tatter part the brace S.W.
 and pleasant Breeze Latitude 40° 30' Long 59°
 Somewhat toward sick and some other things

Tuesday Commenced this day with strong breeze from the S.
 August 11 and pleasant sail on the weather
 Middle and Tatter the same the S.W.
 a current setting to the N.E. and the net
 of 30 fathoms 24 hours to end the
 17000 Lat 40° 36' Long 59° 35'

Wednesday Towards the Western Islands 1841
 August 12 Commenced this day with light breeze from the
 S.W. and pleasant sail some 28 knots
 brace did not get fast midnite brace
 and weather the same Tatter the easting brace
 and squalls of rain to end Latitude 41° 01'
 Longitude 61° 53'

Thursday Thunders twenty four hours beginning with fine breeze
 August 13 from the S.W. & sets a sheet of Grandpauling
 at 11 P.M. ship heading S.W. midnite
 squally furl tops & sails Tatter strong gale
 from the S.W. & double reef tops & sail till
 noon ship heading East to end the day
 Latitude 40° 11' Longitude 61° 56'

Friday Commenced this day with fresh gales from the S.W.
 August 14 midnite heavy squalls once changed Tatter more
 moderate but one reef out of the tops at 10 P.M.
 the wind backed S.W. and thick hazy weather
 Latitude by Account 40° 28' Long 61° 46'

Saturday Begins this day with strong breeze from S.W. and
 August 15 squally midnite the same Tatter part squalls
 attended with rain thunder and lightning being
 observation Latitude by Account 39° 54'
 Long by Chron 61° 34'

Sunday Commenced this day with fresh breeze from the S.W. and
 August 16 squally set the S.W. sail once spanked midnite brace
 and weather the same Tatter part the hauls more to the
 westward to end Latitude by observation 41° 10' North
 Longitude by Chron 61° 29'

Monday Commenced this day with fine breeze from west and
 August 17 pleasant breeze and Tatter part the same
 to end Latitude 40° 10' Long 61° 47'
 12000
