Washed Commenced this day with strong land breeze thick clouds
August 18 weather moderate fresh gales came along the shore in the
Sat. morn and for 4000 P.M. Brown Double masted
sailed for once. began 4000 Sat. the more success
passed all sail. and sent down the flag. 4000
and yards 2 ships in sight 4000 No reference

Medians Bound this day with strong trees from the
August 14 distance at 34m past floor & later years
and ends with the same so ends

Wed. 11th Nov. To Blueny by Account 38¹/₂ Long
Coming this day with strong breeze from the west
August 11th 1720 Anne pleasant at 4 P.M. Water 5 fathoms bearing
E by S by Compass 9. 15 57 miles. Weather pleasant
Hot Day, but clear in with the land at 8 am.
Went ashore to Encey

August 23. Clear with little squally of rain. Breeze the
same. Bottom flat. Wind and weather the same.
To E. Ind. for Johannes 23rd 57. For Providence 23rd 57.

Saturday Commenced this day with fine breeze from the S.W. & clear
 August 29 thick fog both the forenoon and latter part the same
 Sold a ^{very} strong strong NW Po. wind
 Latitude 22° 50' Longitude 25° 33'

Sunday August 30th Announced this day with strong breeze from N by E. and hazy weather middle part the same at day let to be a Breeze Pleasing S by E latter part breeze came thick hazy weather part of Antares Distance 12 leagues To End Latitude 17° 08' Longitude 33° 46'

Monday These twenty four hours being with nine breezes from
August 31st the S^W & East and thick hazy weather. Sudden
squally took in all the sailing at daylight set all
the sails. Latter this day one Colour sailed
17 days. Brought then steering the same way to E
