November 18 Commenced this day with fine breeze from the N. E. all day
Wednesday 18 Set Middle fine breeze latter fine breeze and fair weather
at 11 AM took 4 white whales loaves struck him and

November 19 Commenced this day with calm weather at 12 noon
Thursday 19 Cutting at 2 30 PM finished cutting Salt loaves loaves
at 4 PM started the works midnite finished at 11 PM

November 20 Commenced this day with fresh breeze from the N. E. on

whales loaves did not get fast set double night topped
again started once more To Enes Latitude 35° 53'

November 21 Begins this day with strong breeze from west with all
Friday 21 At 10 o'clock set sail the main Royal and
Afore East by Cons. past Salt Lake fin
a lite breeze from the westward broken clouds

Emp in repairing the fore tops To Enes Long 38° 53'

Monday 24 Weather broke out the fore hole on the Starboard side
and run down yells oil midnite calm heading to the
Southward at day lite bore ship heading with Salt 2 white
whales did not get fast Salt another whale loaves struck
him took him along side To Enes Lat 36° 04'

November 25 Commenced this day with fine breeze and pleasant weather
Tuesday 25 Cut the whale Salt a number of whales at sundown
Emp in boiling and storing oil midnite the whale
to the Starboard latter fresh breeze and thick fog and
many Salt whales 2 loaves twice did not get fast
To Enes Emp in boiling

November 26 Commenced this day with fine weather at sundown took in
Tuesday 26 Sail and bore ship once she was 1/2 E by S at sundown
Salt whales loaves struck one Store 2 Boats killed the
whale with the sword from the three boat in in taking
the other crew To Enes took the Store boat a bore
Emp in boiling Latitude 36° 21' Long 61° 00'

November 27 Commenced this day with fine pleasant weather 1/2 E by S
Wednesday 27 of whales loaves struck him and struck midnite
latter Salt 2 whales struck 2 whales drove from one place
another took him along side and other in
