

Ship Clements of New London 1840

Thursday. Comed this morn with lte bree and foggy Sale
Decem 31. A number of whaled Dols 8 in one jam. boared
Struck our Stow two 48 coast kille the whales took
him along side and let him lay Middle and fore
fresh bree and thick fog and raining at day lte come.
cutting the whale finisht at 5 PM. Stows 57 bbls
down the after hatch. Sale some whaled Camp in
boiling So Cues No 100

1841 January - found the snow gray but thick fog and rising
windy weather the wind from N.W. & moderate fine weather
Latter strong breeze from the S.W. with plenty of W. wind
Scarcely struck on water took him along side camp in
morning 10 o'clock N. O. 1/2

Saturday (contd) this day with calm weather with a heavy S.W. gale.
 January 2 on cut the cable in the Pump well got stops up
 broke in to it found 3 ft of water in the hole finish from
 ship at 12 minutes at the beachy Dater fresh Galey
 from the Westward also 115 bbls oil in the after hold
 Pump in boiling - 43 lbs

Sunday Comes this day with fresh Gale from the N.E. heading
January 8 last at 10. Aloud more moderate. Still calm with a fine
spell on Sat. nothing to excite much in boiling
N. H. Sat 4/12/26 In

Monday Coms this day with calm weather with a heavy swell
January 14 on Choked of the fore hatch. Middle life board
wore ship heading 330. Lathe fast. Gales filled
the Stowage with oil. Exp in burning set the fore
Wop double reef. Looked the ground over. When last
the Chales. No to nothing. Latitude 42.08 (Long)

March 20th Began this day with strong Gales from the S.W.
Saw 5 Migrants the same latter H.C. same as the former
birds building about 60. bled birds down the main
R. Canal. Letter was 23.26 Saw 77 w.

1841 Working to the Eastward 40 cords burned Land
bedded Comb this day with calm weather Saw 2 white whales
Remaind going quick to the N^e middle and latter part the storm
Saw some few Black Petrels h. 2ⁿ 30 Long 76ⁿ 54

Thursday Came this day with fine weather Emp in Cherry Bloss
January 7 and repairing the Boats and bending Sails sent
down the Main royal yard all hands Emp in band
Took 3 white whales board twice did not get fast
Middle and Letter thick foggy weather To End

Friday Boreas this day with thick fog and some heavy snow.
 Emp in Charny Bone Sale one brit. whale 10 cwt
 thick fidd took him along side and cut him in starks
 the work's Middle strong but latter just fides and
 thick fogg and rainy weather Emp in Bottling

Saturday Commenced this day with hard Gales from the N.E. & N.W.
 January 9. and thick foggy & rainy weather, gave us write
 whales too, much to work at. Run down furled the
 Fore-sail Middle and Latter the same at the fore
 saw plenty of write whales finish'd balling & bow'd
 the oil down the after hatch on the Starboard
 Side. Became the Day Latiti. 43. of Long 78. 35 -

Sunday Found this day with hard Gale as usual. Left the
John 10 fore sail and set the main Spencer Middle
and later part the same P. O. Cured

Packed 43-10
Monday Begins this day with fresh sales as usual
January 11 Middle and Lower part the same Packed
Packed 42-13 - Long 84.35-

Good Cond this day with strong breeze west & the weather
fair. (2) Sails nothing. chadelle strong and latter part sailed from
with some thick fog and rain. During P.M. bound to
the standard etc.
