Feb 8 Commenced this day with strong breeze and fair weather
Sunday Middle and Latter strong Gale E. in
Boiling 50 E. 46 10 00 Long 145 00

Monday Begins this day with hard Gale from the Westward
Feb 8 and broken Cloudy weather Middle and Latter part the
same with a very heavy sea on Coast just the main
tops and lower the ship too E. in Boiling 50 E. 46 10 00

Feb 9 Begins this day with more moderate weather Strong
East Middle and Latter strong breeze and dark
Cloudy weather finish the boiling 130 bbls oil
down the after hatch 50 E. 46 10 00

Feb 10 Begins this day with fresh Gale Strong East
Feb 10 under double reef tops the lower 130 bbls Middle
and Latter part windward weather the same 50 E. 46 10 00

Feb 11 Commenced this day with strong breeze from the S.W.
