

1825 Ship Climax of N. W. Sonceon.

August Commenced this day with fresh breeze
Friday 13 from the N. W. saw black fish mackerel
and later fine breeze all sail set.

Latitude 40° 13' Long 53° 38'

August Begins this day with fine breeze
Saturday 14 fair weather Middle and Latter strong.

Sailed and squally at day like saw sperm
whales some gulls. Loared could not
get fast spoke being blown to S. W. at
noon the day. Latitude 40° 30' Long 52° 00'

Sunday Commenced this day with fresh breeze and squally
August 15 Double reefed tops the same all round the
compass Middle and Latter the same one
sail in sight steering the same way.

Latitude 40° 09' Long 51° 18'

Monday All these twenty four hours fine breeze from
August 16 the N. W. all sail set two sails in sight
Cup in setting up main rigging S. W. breeze
at observation.

Tuesday Begins with fresh breeze and dark squally
August 17 weather Middle and Latter the same
at daylight made all sail Latter more fresh.

Latitude 40° 04' Long 51° 48'

Wednesday Commenced this day with fine breeze and squally with light
August 18 squally of rain Middle and Latter the same breeze.

Latitude 39° 54' Long 51° 34'

Thursday Commenced this day with light breeze from the Westward
August 19 attended with light squally of rain Middle and
Latter part the same S. W. breeze.

Latitude 39° 46' Long 51° 00'

Howard the Westernmost 1825

Monday All this day strong breeze from the N. W.
August 20 and fair weather three ships in sight Enes
Latitude 39° 33' Long 52° 08'

Tuesday Sailed breeze from west all sail set
August 21 three ships in sight S. W. breeze
Latitude 38° 45' Long 50° 29'

Wednesday Nine breeze from the N. E. in steady sails
August 22 and voyaged Middle and Latter the same
to the Eastward made good bearing S. E.
by compass S. W. breeze.

September we have had light winds and calms
Sept 24 for the last 10 days saw several sails
one from black fish
to Enes this day
Latitude 32° 09' Long 26° 03'

September Sailed winds and baffling and some rain saw
Friday 31 one sail on our Starboard hough Middle and
Latter the same Latitude 31° 24' Long 26° 04'

Saturday Begins this day with fine breeze from East
September 1 spoke the Hummibal day Harbor let him C. 75
have my watch Middle and Latter strong
breeze from the Eastward the Hummibal in Comp
S. W. breeze split main royal and wizen top with Gen
Latitude 25° 33' Long 26° 21'

Sunday Begins this day with strong breeze Cup in repairing
September 2 sailed at fore top shading sail Middle and Latter
the same the Hummibal in company S. W. breeze
Latitude 22° 27' Long 26° 39'

Monday All these twenty four hours strong breeze winds
September 3 set main royal and main top fine sail En
29 days the Hummibal in Comp
Latitude 19° 22' Long 26° 47'
