the black fish board did not get fast Enos

September 6th N.W. Middle and Latter the same set all
the day sail took in the Starboard anchor
to Enos — Latitude 9° 30' Long Chron 23° 16'

Monday Begins this day with fine breeze from the N.W. all
September 7th sail set — Middle and Latter more to the south
middle took a heavy squall from the N.W. took in
at the sail canvas away the main top and
boom one man fell from the main yard over
fortunately saved him Latter the baffling winds
one sail in sight set some fish. Back to Enos

September 9th Middle and Latter the same breeze from the N.W. set all
the day sail to Enos Latitude 6° 27' Long 19° 20'

Thursday Begins this day with fine breeze from the N.W.
September 10th the day sail set all the day sail to Enos
in the morning sail Latter calm and rainy the black
fish to Enos this day

Latitude 5° 06' Longitude 19° 28' 34"

Friday Begins this day with the breeze from the N.W. dark heavy clouds.
September 11th in the horizon middle field, foggy and soft sail
Latter fresh breeze from the N.W. single reef top sail

September 12th weather spoke black fish Middle the same
Latter the same as the former to Enos

and weather the same Latter more moderate out reef
set fly abt to Enos

September 14th Middle and Latter the same spoke a Brazilian brig
to Enos this day
