

Friday Ship Climatic of New London 1851
Thursday Comes this day with fresh gales and dark rain
December 11 weather clearing P.E. at dark huff on a breeze
to the westward Middle and later foggy
Saw fin backs no white whales Emp in boiling

Saturday Begins this day with fresh breeze from N.E. P.E.
December 12 P.E. finished boiling Stowed the same latter
stowed 60 blb oil down the main hatch. Saw 2 white
whales going quick to the south. So ends
Latitude 39° 45' Long 69° 06'

Sunday Comes this day with calm. Weather clear. At 10
December 13 to the north saw 3 white whales. Struck
the three whales. Killed took them along side and
cut them in 2 Emps
Latitude 39° 35' Long 75° 00'

Monday Begins this day with fine weather. Saw 1
December 14 loaded struck one whale took him along
side and cut him in 2. Took the black. Saw of
7 months out 10 white whales 3 Apr. Saw
he take a whale. Middle and later
Latitude 39° 11' Long 73° 40'

Tuesday Comes this day with strong breeze fresh
December 15 Top Gallant Sails. Saw 2 white whales
loaded struck one whale took him along
side coming cutting at 8 P.M. finished
at 11 midnight. Pleasant latter. Saw
white whales. Struck killed the two whales
one struck the other & calf took him along
side and cut the strong out. Ends in
Latitude 38° 31' Long 76° 40'

139 Days 11 Whales

1841 Cruising for Whales to the west of N
Friday Comes this day with fresh breeze. Saw two
December 16 white whales. Struck one. Drained from the
other. Middle fresh gales from N.E. Latter the same
hauled the fore sail up. Stowed 120 blb oil down
the fore hatch. Emp in boiling. So ends the day.
Saw some fin backs
Latitude 38° 47' Long 76° 20'

Saturday Comes this day with fresh gales from the west
December 16 with a heavy sea on middle the same latter part
stowed P.E. saw no white whales. Emp in boiling
So ends Latitude 38° 32' Longitude 77° 05'

Sunday All these twenty four hours fresh gales from the
December 17 Westward. Saw nothing. Made the S.E. of St Paul's
bearing E by N 10 S. Under huff on a breeze to the
Northward in midnite loose ship. At day light there
is for the same went in shore and caught some
fish. Saw one white whale. Spoke the Barque
Action of J.B. Bedford 7 months out 9 whales &
found the chronometer 30 miles to the Eastward
Latitude 38° 48' Long 78° 12'

Monday Comes this day with fresh breeze and squally weather
December 18 Saw 2 white whales too rugged to whale. Middle
and latter strong gales and dark cloudy weather
the finisher boiling stowed 100 blb oil down the
main hatch. So ends the day
Latitude by AC 39° 45' Long 77° 30'

Tuesday Begins this day with fresh gales with a heavy
December 19 sea on middle calm latter strong breeze. Strong
East saw some fin backs. So ends the day
Latitude 40° 01' Longitude 79° 35'
