 Saturday Commenced this day with strong trade wind from the S.W. at 10 o'clock
 June 4 Sailed took 5 hals a number took them
 along side and set them free
 Latitude 19° 30' Long 110°
 Sunday Contd the whale and started the work
 June 5 Middle and latter fine weather
 Wednesday We have been baffling since looking for
 June 15 Sailed some Black fish to end this day
 lost like ever as usual
 Latitude 22° 47' Long 143° 30'
 Thursday Begins this day with the wind from the S.W.
 June 16 Middle and latter calm
 No observations
 Friday Commenced this day with calm weather middle
 June 17 and latter like baffling wind
 No observations
 Saturday Begins this day with the wind from the S.W. and dark clouds
 June 18 weather middle the same latter strong breeze from
 the Southward ended Latitude 23° 47'
 Sunday Commenced this day with strong breeze from the South
 June 19 Middle for the top gallant sailed latter more
 moderate made all sail ended
 Latitude 23° 33' Long 138° 11'
 Monday Commenced this day with fresh breeze and squally
 June 20 Middle the same at day light made the land
 of the Gambier Islands bearing East 10 miles
 latter calm ended Latitude 23° 08' Long 135° 30'
 Tuesday Begins this day with fresh breeze and squally
 June 21 Double reefed tops Steered

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Working Eastward 1842
 Monday Commenced this day with fresh breeze and squally
 June 20 the same at 8 o'clock ship heading 80° E. Middle made
 and weather the same latter moderate at
 day light made a small sb bearing East 10 miles
 it is surrounded by a coral reef the highest part of it
 is the north end is about 15 feet above water with some
 trees on it It is in Latitude 23° 20' Long 137° 50' more
 and it is not laid down on no chart or epitome that
 I have ever seen
 Tuesday Begins this day with the wind from the S.W. of the land
 June 21 Intention to go on shore took away heavy squall from
 the S.W. kept the ship before the wind and double
 reefed the tops kept up East by North by compass
 Middle fresh gales latter squally at 9 am made
 the Gambier sb bearing East by North 10 miles
 Latitude 23° 04' Long 135° 18' at 4 pm
 Wednesday Commenced this day with the baffling breeze middle
 June 22 calm latter the same wind in sight ended
 No observations
 Thursday Commenced this day with the wind from the South West
 June 23 a sperm whale bore chase him at sundown
 went on and shot him or shot on him
 middle and latter calm ended in making a
 fly sblooms ended Latitude 23° 33' Long 135° 33'
 Friday Begins this day with calm weather middle and latter
 June 24 the same the land in sight ended Latitude 23° 32'
 Saturday Commenced this day with fine breeze from the S.W.
 June 25 Middle same latter wind hauled the land and squally
 saw fin back land in sight
