Sunday Begins this day with dark squally weather
June 26 Light Breeze Midnite rainy Latter fresh breeze from
SE set fore top Mast sail

Latitude 24°33 Long 134°14

Monday Commences this day with fine breeze and fair weather
June 27 Steering East Midnite Double reef Tops-Latter
Latter strong Gale and squally Ends

Latitude 25°10 Long Chen 131°31

Tuesday Begins this day with strong breeze from the SE and
June 28 squally Middle the same at 11 AM Made
Perkins 1st bearing East 90 S Longues
took in sail and let on a brace Latter made sail
and stored in for the same Ends Long 130°36

Wednesday Commences this day with fine weather sent the
June 29 Boat ashore and got some potatoes
Latter nothing Ends the day

Thursday Fine pleasant weather Ship laying off and on
June 30 Middle and Latter calm

Friday Commences this day with calm weather sent out a
June 31 into Schoon and fly 1st Boon Middle
and Latter the same Ends the same in sight

Saturday Light breeze and fair weather all this morning
July 2 East Latitude 25°10 Long by Sun 128°

Sunday Begins this day with fresh breeze from the
July 3 North West Middle and Latter the same

Latitude 25°25 Long by Sun 126°09 by Chron

Monday Commences this day with fresh breeze fresh top Gallant
July 4 sails saw some thump Boats Middle and Latter
and the same Ends Latitude 25°50 Long by Sun 122°35

Towards the Coast of Chili 1832

Tuesday Commences this day with fresh breeze and squally
July 5 weather Employed in repairing the fore tops

Middle and Latter the same Late thump Boats
Latitude 26°15 Long 119°35

Wednesday Begins this day with strong breeze from the SE and spray
July 6 Midnite wind and weather the same Latter more moderate
Course Chaffs Late fine Boats

Thursday Commences this day with strong breeze from the SE and
July 7 some passing clouds Middle and Latter squally

Latitude 26°26 Long by Sun 115°10

Friday Begins this day with strong breeze from the SE and
July 8 squally fresh fly 1st and top Gallant sails at
three PM Late two sperm whales were struck
one later took him along side and took in sail
Midnite the same Latter more moderate with a large
Wave on Comm cutting the water Go Ends the day

Latitude 26

Saturday Commences this day with light breeze from the SE finish
July 9 cutting the whale and Bala the case Middle and
Latter calm started the works Go Ends the day

Latitude 25°33 Long 115°39

Sunday Begins this day with light breeze from East East Ship
July 10 heading South Middle light baffling winds Latter light
breeze from the SE Emp in Boiling Ends

Latitude 26°00 Long 114°20

Monday Commences this day with light breeze from west Area Cher
July 11 weather Middle and Latter the same Emp in Boiling

Latitude 26°16 Long 113°46

Tuesday Begins this day with light breeze and fair weather
July 12 Middle calm finish boiling Latter squally Ends
