 August 16 lay up to under fore sail and double reef  
 Nelson's Top's Cup in repairing Main Top's  
 Wednesday We have strong gales from the S.E. at Double  
 August 17 reef Top's Ends  
 Latitude 22° 50' Long 87° 40'  
 Thursday Commences this day with more moderate weather  
 August 18 Set single reef Top's Sail Nothing  
 Latitude 24° 04'  
 Friday Begins this day with pleasant breeze from  
 August 19 S.W. and dark cloudy weather midnight  
 the same latter made all sail Ends  
 Latitude 25° 05' Long 88° 23'  
 Saturday Commences this day with lile breeze all day  
 August 20 fog squally Middle and latter the same  
 Latitude 25° 30' Long 89° 00'  
 Sunday Commences this day with lile air from the S.E. and  
 August 21 cloudy sail a large sperm whale going to the  
 windward board did not see him from the  
 boats come aboard as well off as we was before  
 Latitude 25° 38' Long 89° 40'  
 Monday Begins this day with lile air at midnight fog squally  
 August 22 sail a sail on our Starboard bow the first  
 we have seen for three months To Ends  
 Latitude 26° 10' Long 90° 00'  
 Tuesday Lile air and clear weather sail nothing  
 August 23 Commences this day with lile baffling winds  
 August 24 Steering East Middle the same latter  
 fresh gales from the N.W. Latitude 27° 00' Long 88° 40'

 August Commences this day with fresh gales from the S.W. and  
 Thursday 25 fair weather Middle and latter the same  
 Latitude 26° 36' Long 87° 40'  
 August Begins this day with fresh gales from the S.E. and  
 Friday 26 squally weather Middle and latter the same  
 but the main spruce so Ends  
 Latitude 27° 40' Long 88° 14'  
 August Commences this day with the wind East by in squally  
 Saturday 27 Middle and latter the same sail nothing Ends  
 Latitude 27° 40' Long 88° 14'  
 August Commences this day with strong breeze from South Ship  
 Sunday 28 heading to S.W. Middle and latter lile baffling winds  
 Latitude 28° 05' Long 88° 58'  
 August Begins this day with lile air and calm  
 Monday 29 Middle and latter the same Ends  
 Latitude 28° 36' Long 89° 40'  
 August Commences this day with lile breeze from the S.W. 89° 40'  
 Tuesday 30 Steering S.W. Middle and latter fine breeze  
 some passing clouds Ends  
 Latitude 30° 19' Long 86° 29'  
 Wednesday Begins this day with fresh breeze from the S.W. and  
 August 31 cloudy Middle the same latter wind hauled S.W.  
 in a squall double reef Top's Ends  
 Latitude 30° 31' Long 85° 50'  
 Thursday Commences this day with strong breeze from the S.W. and  
 August squally Midnight the same latter strong gales  
 September 1 with a very heavy sea on Ends  
 Latitude 31° 30' Long 82° 55'  
 Friday Fresh gales from the S.W. and squally sail  
 September 2 a fine bark and some porpoises Ends  
 Latitude 31° 58' Long 82° 16'
