- Thursday Commenced this day with strong gales from S.W.
 October 4 Midnite were Ship to the S.E. Latter the same
 Camp in boiling and setting up Shacks
 Latitude 36° 18' Long 74° 20'
- Friday Commenced this day with moderate gales from
 October 5 East cloudy weather saw number of Wharves
 Camp in boiling
 Latitude 36° 38' Long 74° 00'
- Thursday Commenced this day with strong breeze from S.W.
 October 6 Midnite like wind - Latter calm flower
 125 bbls spun oil down board for hump back
 got nothing Ends - Land in sight
 Latitude 36° 30' Long 73° 50'
- Friday Begins this day with strong breeze from S.W.
 October 7 Weathered harbor in sight
 Middle and latter the same Ends
 Lat 36° 22'
- Sunday Commenced with like winds with a heavy swell on
 October 9 Saw a ship to the Northward steering East
 Midnite wind freshens steering in towards the
 land at 12 o'clock saw the land at 1 o'clock William
 Robertson fell over board while taking the fly 16 saw
 him bent the chains to Ends
- Monday Packed Quarkine at 2 P.M. at 7 P.M. Camp
 October 10 in few fathoms water the fort bearing West
 South the Custom House bearing S.E. by S
 Midnite blew strong Latter Camp in scrap
 Ship and cutting off water
- Thursday Fine breeze from the South the Sparter
 October 11 on Kentucky came to an anchor
 Wednesday Fine Southerly winds to Ends the Day
 October 12

 October 15 Commenced with fine weather Most of the
 Valdivia Men forwarded down duty Ship ready for
 October 16 Sea Calm came aboard Port there was
 the Callabado the others went to their
 duty to Ends
- Sunday Most of the Men came to their duty the
 October 17 other Discharged to Ends
 You pay Girls of Valdivia this Day I must see you
 Monday Got under way with a fine breeze from
 October 18 the South in company with the Bergey
 General of Adam Capt Stafford Ends
- Friday Commenced this day with fine fresh standing off
 October 19 from the Line Middle Squally Latter
 Fleet Ship to the Southward Ends
 Latitude 36° 07'
- Saturday Commenced this day with strong gales from
 October 20 S.W. and squally Middle and Latter the
 same Ends Latitude 36° 39' Long 75° 45'
- Thursday Begins this day with fresh breeze from the S.W.
 October 21 and pleasant Middle and Latter the
 same Ends
 Latitude 36° 43'
- Friday Strong winds and Southerly Opened the Branch
 October 22 and Balfre 34 months out 500 Bound in to Valdivia
 to Eng. Lat. nothing Latitude 36° 44' Long 75° 00'
