

Ship Clematis of. Anderson 1842

Saturday Commenced this day with fresh Gales from NW
November 5 and ran up shore ship and cut the whale
to leeward took the Philip Gale of Warren
Middle and Satter fresh breeze Emp in
Boiling Ems

Latitude 40° 48' Long 76° 20'

Sunday Begins this day with fresh breeze and fair weather
November 6 two ships in sight. Gale and whale to leeward
Middle and Satter the same

Latitude 40° 38' Long 76° 00'

Monday Commenced this day with strong breeze from SE the Philip Gale
November 7 in sight - saw one wide whale Middle found the boiling
Satter the same

Latitude 40° 13' Long 77° 00'

Tuesday Begins this day with fresh breeze from west heading
November 8 South Gale nothing set the bit bellocum diked

So Ends Latitude 39° 49' Long 76° 20'

Wednesday Begins this day with fresh breeze and fair weather
November 9 Ship heading SSE Middle wind hauls SE Satter
the same saw nothing Ends

Latitude 40° 36' Long 76° 50'

Thursday Begins this day with calm weather found let me
November 10 the Store Boat Middle and Satter calm and
raining. Satter nothing

Latitude 40° 44' Long 77° 06'

Friday Commenced this day with fresh breeze from SE
November 11 saw plenty of wide whales saw eight in one
bore leeward struck two sunk one saw the
other Midnight. fresh Gales Satter the same
bore ship and cut the whale to leeward
one ship in sight

Latitude 40° 48' Long 77° 50'

Cruising for whales on the coast of Chile 1842

Saturday Commenced this day with fresh Gales from SE set top
November 12 Double reefed at Anderson saw Number of whales
Middle More Moderate Satter fine breeze from the South
saw whales leeward struck one and took him along side
and cut him in and mist another End the day
with plenty of whales in sight

Latitude 40° 08' Long 77° 53'

Sunday Begins this day with fine weather took a whale and
November 13 cut him in Midnight pleasant Satter the same Emp
in boiling Ems

Latitude 40° 08' Long 77° 51'

Monday Commenced this day with fine pleasant weather saw plenty
November 14 whales struck three sunk the line parted from
the other Midnight Calm Satter fresh Gales
and thick raining weather

Latitude 40° 53' Long 78° 10'

Tuesday Fresh Gales and clear weather saw South
November 15 one ship in sight Middle and Satter more
Moderate saw some whales Emp in Boiling

Latitude 40° 49' Long 78° 20'

Wednesday Commenced this day with fresh breeze saw whales leeward
November 16 did not yet fast Middle and Satter breeze
and weather the same Emp in boiling saw whales

Latitude 40° 14'

Thursday Begins this day with fresh Gales from the west
November 17 saw a bit between decks took in sail too rough
to whales Middle and Satter the same Ends

Latitude 41° 09' Long 78° 17'

Friday Commenced this day with fresh breeze with a heavy swell on
November 18 saw whales leeward struck one and took him along side
let him lay too long to cut Midnight fresh Gales
Satter the same bore ship and cut the whale to
leeward No other
