

Ship Clematis New London

Monday October 16 1854

Begins with light breezes from N^W with
rain squalls steering E by N with all sail set
at 4 PM blows on fresh with rain took in studding
sails last part fresh breezes and pleasant weather
hove a new flying jib Lat 34° 36' Long 157° 40'

Tuesday Oct 17

Begins with fresh breezes from N^W E heading East
at night blows on heavy in squalls with pleas-
ant of rain I amble reef the topsails took in
jib and mainsail last part light breezes from E^{SE} E
and pleasant weather Lat 35° 44' Long 156° 00'

Wednesday Oct 18

Begins with light breeze from E^{SE} E heading S E
two sails in sight last part light breezes from
West steering E by N Lat 35° 10' Long 155° 00'

Thursday Oct 19

Come with light breezes from the Westward and
pleasant weather steering E^{SE} E with all sail
set threw the night heavy rain squalls last
part pleasant weather Lat 33° 20' Long 152° 10'

Friday Oct 20

Begins with pleasant breeze from West steering E^{SE} E
with all sail set spark ship Carries New Bedford
bore to Sandwich Islands middle and last part
fresh breezes and squally Lat 33° 34' Long 149° 15'

Saturday Oct 21

Begins with fresh breezes from West steering E^{SE} E
with all sail set last part fresh gales and heavy
rain squally Lat 33° 40' Long 146° 00'

Bound To The Coast of California 1854

Sunday October 22

Begins with fresh gales from West with heavy rain^{all day}
steering East with all sail set a heavy swell
leaving from West at night reefed fore and
mizen topmasts last part weather more moderate
made all sail Lat 34° 20' Long 142° 50'

Monday October 23

Begins with fresh gales from West and clear
weather steering East E by N with all sail set
last part wind from the Northward and
squally Lat 35° 12' Long 140° 08'

Tuesday October 24

Begins with fresh breezes from the Northward
and squally weather steering East with all
sail set middle and last part weather the
same Lat 35° 40' Long 137° 10'

Wednesday October 25

Come with strong winds from the Northward
with heavy squalls steering East with gale^{all day}
last part light breezes from N^W Lat 32° 16' Long 134° 00'

Thursday Oct 26

Come with light breezes from West steering E by N
with all sail set hove a new mainmast
stepped last part wind light squalls with rain
squalls Lat 32° 10' Long 131° 20'

Friday October 27

Begins with light breezes from West with rain squalls
steering East with all sail set last part wind
or the same Lat 31° 30' Long 129° 20'
