

Ship Clematis New London

Thursday November 16th

Begins with fine weather steering East with all sail set with light breeze from N^W At 10 saw the land bearing East Distance 50 miles kept off S^E for Mariak Islands got a lunar observation Chronometer 39 miles out of the way by Lunar Observation Lat 18.21 Long by Chron 167.41.30 by Lunar Observation Dist 107.10.45 2 Distance 106 59.45

Friday November 17th

Begins with pleasant breeze from N^W steering S^E by S at 6 P.M. Mariak Islands bore S^E Dist 10 miles took in galleons till morning At 10 kept off S^E at twelve land 2 miles Distance Thus Ends

Saturday November 18th

Begins with light breeze from N^W and pleasant weather at 5 P.M. came to anchor between N^W Island and S^E two miles from shore in 16 fathoms water went in shore after the wood found it very small and soggy At 3 three boats went in three wooding saw the remains of an old house and a lot of Spanish reader barrels on the beach brought a lot of them off and some of the hull for wood Thus Ends

Sunday November 19

Begins with fine weather employed wooding last part weather the same as the former Thus Ends

Monday November 20

Begins with fine weather boats went shore the men had a run at night they brought off a lot of lumber At 10 sent all three boats shore wooding Thus Ends

Tuesday November 21

Begins with fine weather employed wooding saw some very large snakes on shore and plenty of scorpions At 10 came on a heavy thunder squall last part dark dirty rainy weather showed the wood below Thus Ends

Wednesday November 22

Begins with dark dirty rainy weather showed the lumber between decks at 5 P.M. blew fresh in squalls on shore got under way stood out clear of the Islands last part calm and cloudy Thus Ends

Thursday Nov 23

Begins with calm weather at night heavy squalls lowered with sharp lightning last part calm Thus Ends

Friday November 24

Begins with calm weather at night light breeze from N^W working up to the land middle fresh breeze stood close in to the land last part light breeze and calm weather Thus Ends

Saturday November

Begins with light breeze and calm weather No wind to get to the anchorage threw the night fine breeze at 7 A.M. came to anchor in 12 fathoms water one mile from shore on the S^E side of the island got off four barrels of wood Thus Ends
