

Ship Clementis New London

Sunday November 26

Begins with fine breeze from the Northward
employed wooding at night got off four barrels
of wood being all we want & No calm at
11 & No light breeze from the Northward took
anchor and went to sea steered off to the
East of the Island to hold the wind Thus Ends

Monday November 27

Begins with fine breeze from N^W steering
S^E at night steered S^W south Island 8 miles
Distance at 8 & No saw two sperm whale going
quick N^W but did not get fast Mariah
Islands bearing North East 30 miles Thus Ends

Tuesday November 28

Begins with light breeze from the Northward
and calm weather at 4 P. M. saw a school
of small sperm whale heard got one saw
porpoises and blackfish among
them cut the whale in started the water
last part calm Ends The Day
Lat 20° 40' Long

Wednesday November 29

Begins with calm weather saw a school of
blackfish heard did not get fast at 8 & No
saw a Sulphur Bottom shot a hump lance
in to him let the whale spouting but got fast
and dumb better luck next time
Lat 19° 50' Long 106° 50'

Thursday November 30

Begins with light breeze from the Northward
last part the same employed repairing the boats
saw plenty of porpoises Thus Ends
Lat 18° 10' Long 106°

Bound To the Southwest

Friday December 1st 1854

Begins with light breeze and calm weather steering
south saw porpoises employed repairing boats
middle and last part weather the same as
the former employed repairing the boats
Lat 18° 04' Long 107° 55'

Saturday December 2nd

Begins with calm weather as usual last part
light breeze from S^E heading S^W saw porpoises
Lat 16° 34' Long 108° 00'

Sunday December 3

Begins with light breeze from S^E heading S^W
last part fresh breeze from East saw plenty of birds
but no whale
Lat 15° 50' Long 108° 30'

Monday December 4

Comm with fresh breeze from East steering South
last part wind light and variable
Lat 14° 25' Long 109° 20'

Tuesday December 5

All these 24 hours light breeze and calm
weather
Lat 10° 40' Long 110° 29'

Wednesday December 6

All this day light breeze and calm weather sent
down the main top galmast repaired the rigging
Lat 10° 09' Long

Thursday December 7

Begins with calm weather and ends the same
found the main topmast rotten in the field
hole repaired it set the rigging up &c
Thus Ends
Lat 10° 10' Long
