

Ship Clemares New London

Monday March 5th

Begins with heavy gales from W and W.S.W.
Split the foremast cable all hands on deck
It bent as new one kept off N.W. by N. lowered
three between Mower and Cowhee heavy squalls
and plenty of rain at 6 P.M. cleared up seas
Mowhee being W by N Dist 10 miles wind S.W.
steering N.W. to clear Mowhee threw the night
baffling wind and clear weather last part strong
breezes from N.W. Thus Ends

Tuesday March 6th

Begins with strong breezes from N.W. working
towards mowhee threw the night calm last part
light breeze from the Northward Thus Ends

Wednesday March 7th

Begins with light breezes from the Northward bound
bound in to Mowhee chronometer 10 miles to far
to the Westward by the land at 8 P.M. came to
anchor A.M. went on shore entered the ship
at last part fine weather Thus Ends

Thursday March 8th

Begins with light breezes from N.E. and pleasant
weather the 6 ships lying near A.M. got my
potatoes aboard 75 barrels and one hundred pumpkins
Thus Ends

Friday March 9th

Begins with fine weather Joseph water get
Drunk raising the Deadey threw the night
fine weather in the morning I took 8 Portuguese
boys on shore shift them on a lay they being
disappointed they being disappointed on the land
they agreed upon at the western island
Thus Ends

Bound on to the Whaling Ground

Saturday March 10th

Begins with fine weather at 6 P.M.
got every thing aboard got under way
for Honolulu middle and last part calm
Lat 20.41 Long 157.18
By Chronometer

Sunday March 11th

Begins with calm weather last part light
breezes from the southward steering for
Honolulu Thus Ends

Monday March 12th

Begins with light breezes from the
southward at 6 P.M. Honolulu harbor
here N.W. about 10 miles blows on fresh
from the southward took ship heading
E.S.E. middle and last part fresh gales with
rain. close reef the topsails
Thus Ends

Tuesday March 13th

Begins with fresh gales from S.W. with
heavy rains middle and last part winds light
and baffling with a heavy swell heaving from
S.W. Thus Ends

Wednesday March 14th

Begins with light breeze from N.W.
heading for Honolulu at 8 P.M. took
in gallant sails lay aback land 6 miles
Distance A.M. went in shore and got a
basket of fish at Sakina
Thus Ends
