close reef topsails set heading N by W (East
last part weather the same Lat 29.54 Long 180.30

Monday April 9th

Begins with strong gales from N E heading
N N W last part weather more moderate
wind N N E ordered the foremast bent a new one

Tuesday April 10th

Begins with strong breezes from N N E
at 4 P.M. when ship heading E N E last part
wind N W heading N E by North
Lat 30.35 Long 179.00

Wednesday April 11

Begins with strong breezes from N W and
squally weather last part weather the same
Lat 31.30 Long 178.54 West

Begins with strong breezes from the Northward
heading N E and E N E middle fresh gales with lightning
last wind the same with cloudy weather No observation
By Sea Lat 31.52 Long 178.00

Friday April 13

Begins with fresh gales from the Northward with fresh
squally weather last part weather the same No observation
By Sea Lat 32.00 Long 176.30

Saturday April 14

Begins with strong gales from the Northward heading
E N E with close reef topsails set middle and last
part weather about the same Lat 31.25 Long 175.55

Sunday April 15th

Begins with fresh gales from the Northward when
ship heading N W by W with double reef topsails set
head wind and likely to remain so last part weather
more moderate set hull topsails Lat 31.45 Long 174.20

Monday April 16th

Begins with light gales from the Northward and squally
weather when ship heading E N E with all sail set
last part light breezes and cloudy weather
Lat 32.10 Long 174.40

Tuesday April 17th

Begins with strong breezes from the Northward
and cloudy at night with light and hailing with
rain squalls middle and last part clear weather
Lat 32.25 Long 173.50
