Begins with fresh gales from SE with plenty of rain and foggy steering NW by W with Double reef topsails set last part light breeze from NE

Saturday April 21

Begins with calm weather and foggy at 8 P.M. light breeze from SW squally and last part the same
Lat 37°45' Long 170°32'

Sunday April 22

Begins with light breeze from SW steering N by E carpenter employed making Davis for her boat last part moderate breeze from South with sun foggy
Lat 38°53' Long 169°40'

Monday April 23th

Begins with strong breeze from South steering N by E at 8 P.M. wind hauled to the Westward steering N by E last part light breeze and cloudy weather

Begins with light gales from W by S steering N by E with all sail set last part light breeze from S by W with a heavy swell on
Lat 45°25' Long 159°34'

Friday April 27

Begins with light breeze from S by W steering South saw a school of blackfish bound did not get past at night wind ~~the~~ South steering N by E by S last part wind S by W steering South

Saturday April 28

Begins with light breeze from S by W steering South fine weather but no whale last part wind South
Lat 48°48' Long 156°00'

Sunday April 29

Begins with fresh gales from the Southward at 8 P.M. wind hauled to the Westward in a heavy squall took in fore and main topsails also set the main last part heavy gales from W by N with snow squalls
