saw one loured went on to him and settled
whale very shy at night saw ship heading
to the Northward A.M. saw one whale loured went
on to him and settled Lat 58° 24 Long 143° 15

Monday May 21st
Begins with light breeze from S.W. steering to
the Northward at night steering E by N per compass
A.M. saw plenty of sulphur balloons saw two
rite whale loured went on to them and settled
whale very shy Lat 58° 48 Long 141° 12

Tuesday May 22nd
Begins with light breeze from the Southward
at 4 PM saw 5 right whale loured went on
to them and settled saw three more
got fast and runaway better luck
hear after 9 hope last part strong gales
from East with plenty of rain. Saw a whale
breaching No Observations By Ace

Begins with fresh gales from East at 6 PM were
ship heading S.W. last part calm and raining
saw one rite whale soon went out of
light in the fog Ends No Observation
By Ace Lat 58° 30 Long 141° 20

Thursday May 24th
Begins with calm weather with sun rain and
fog saw one rite whale loured did not get fast
at night fresh breeze from East with plenty
of rain saw one rite whale going quick to wind
ward A.M. saw a whale loured did not get fast last
part strong breeze from the Eastward saw plenty of
finbacks Lat 58° 48 Long 141° 52

Friday May 25th
Begins with fresh breeze from the Eastward
heading S by E at 4 PM saw ship heading
N by N North saw plenty of finbacks
last part calm and pleasant saw plenty of
finbacks saw the land Mount St. Elias bearing
N by E 1/2 East dist 50 miles chronometer 8 miles
West of it Lat 58° 56 Long by Chron 142° 45

Saturday May 26th
Begins with calm weather saw finbacks
land 40 miles distance very high covered with
snow at night light breeze from West steering
E.S.E. A.M. saw two right whale loured did not
get fast saw another with craft in him
this Ends Lat 59° 38 Long 141° 00

Sunday May 27th
Begins with light breeze from West steering
S.E. saw plenty of sulphur balloons
saw the land dist 40 miles last part strong
breeze heading S by W Lat 57° 17 Long 141° 45

Monday May 28th
Begins with fresh breeze from West heading S by W
saw plenty of finbacks last part calm saw finbacks
Lat 57° 00 Long 142° 00
